April 14, 2026

Meeting called to order at 7:01PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call: Trustee Scheuneman, Trustee Kelly, Trustee Schrems, President Fish and Clerk Hart were present. Trustee T. Fish was absent.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the agenda with the addition of attorney Adam Flory being listed as a guest speaker, seconded by Kelly. Motion carried.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the March minutes as read, seconded by Schrems. Motion carried.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as read, seconded by Kelly. Clerk Hart made a note that she transferred tax money collected for sewer and special assessments. She transferred \$62664.49 from General fund to WWSAS, and \$14525.85 from General fund to O&M checking. Motion carried.

Scheuneman made a motion to accept the police report, seconded by Schrems. Motion carried.

## DPW/Wastewater

President Fish noted that a lot of rainwater had fallen over the last week or so. The railroad bridge drain was plugged but he fixed it. He also noted that the lagoons were in the process of being treated and discharged.

## Guest Speakers

Adam Flory from Smith Bovill was present to introduce himself to the council and public. His firm handles issues for municipalities and currently serves around 45 municipalities in the state.

## Old Business

Clerk Hart reported her findings on CD rates for PFCU, UFCU, and Frankenmuth Credit Union. Frankenmuth Credit Union is going to give the best rates by far.

## New Business

## Public Comment


