Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Checks returned due to non-sufficient funds will be assessed a \$30 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms or those with insufficient entry fees will be returned.

Electronic entries will be accepted. Email your complete and signed entry form to the trial secretary. A Square invoice will be emailed to you (including a 3.0% plus \$.30 service fee) Once your payment has been received, your entry will be processed. Confirmation of entry will be sent via email if an email address is included on the entry form

Directions to trial site: Czechmate Dog Sports is located northwest of Rockford IL.

From the north: I-90 to IL route 75 (first IL exit). West on IL 75 about 16 miles to Harrison Rd. South on Harrison Rd 1.5 miles to 10321 Harrison Rd.

From the south or east: I-90 to US Route 20 bypass. West on Route 20 (towards Freeport) to Meridian Rd exit (last Rockford exit). North on Meridian about 5 miles to IL route 70 (4-way stop also marked as Trask Bridge Rd/Kilburn Ave). West on Route 70 to Harrison Rd. North on Harrison Rd 5 miles to 10321 Harrison Rd on the right.

Policies & Notices to Exhibitors

- Trial location available 7 AM to 6 PM each day or until one hour after event
- Bath/cool off tub provided
- Owners or agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.
- Exhibitors are expected to cleanup after their dogs.
- Bitches in season will be allowed to participate; they will run in catalog order.
- ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or otherwise restricted except when working. Under NO circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena during another dog's performance. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding Regulations)
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, not allowed to compete, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the show committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of monies will be made
- Heartland BC Club of IL does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline" and the "Regulations for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be abused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case if any injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any dam-age. I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight. ***I (we) agree that any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance at the event between the AKC and the event-giving club (unless otherwise stated in its premium list) and myself(ourselves) or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association. However, prior to arbitration all applicable AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and procedures must first be followed as set forth in the AKC charter and bylaws, rules, regulations, published policies and guidelines.***
