

Senior Activity Center of Smyrna

Policy: Inclement Weather/Local, State or National Emergency

Purpose: To let our members know about Center closings in case of inclement weather, i.e. – snow, ice, rain and flooding, fog, tornadoes, earthquakes and other natural disasters. In addition, this policy will cover local, state or national emergencies, i.e. – epidemics and pandemics (2020 COVID-19) as well as protests and riots.

Procedure: The Senior Activity Center of Smyrna follows the Rutherford County School schedule for school closings caused by inclement weather. Members will be notified via Facebook and website but should also pay attention to local news stations for announcement of Rutherford County School closings.

The only exception to this policy is if the announcement is made the night before that schools will be closed for snow or ice that is predicted to fall overnight but does not fall. Then, the Center will be open for activities.

In case of a local, state or national emergency, the Senior Activity Center Board of Directors will act according to recommendations from the CDC, federal, state and local governments and local health professionals to determine the appropriate actions to be taken regarding Center closings.

This policy will also apply to activities that occur on Fridays when the Center is officially closed.

Results: Following this policy keeps our members and staff safe which is a priority.
