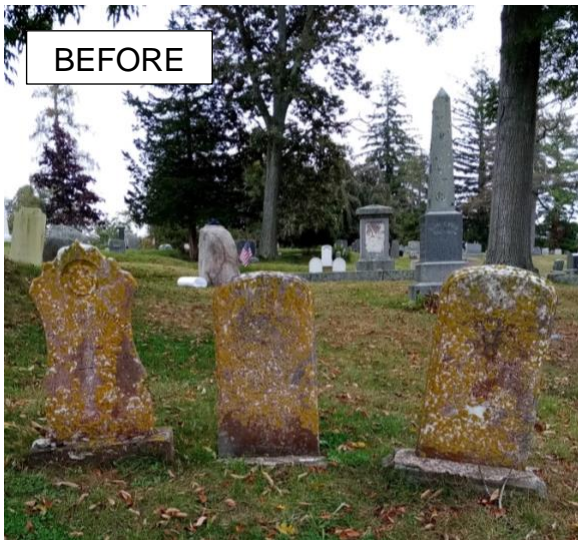

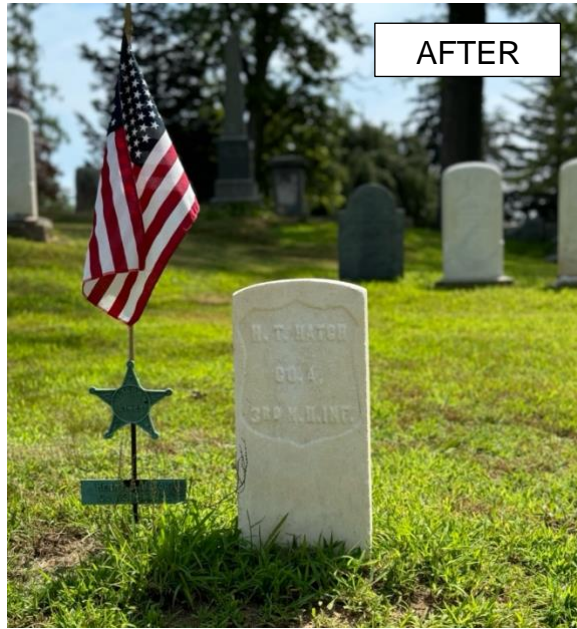
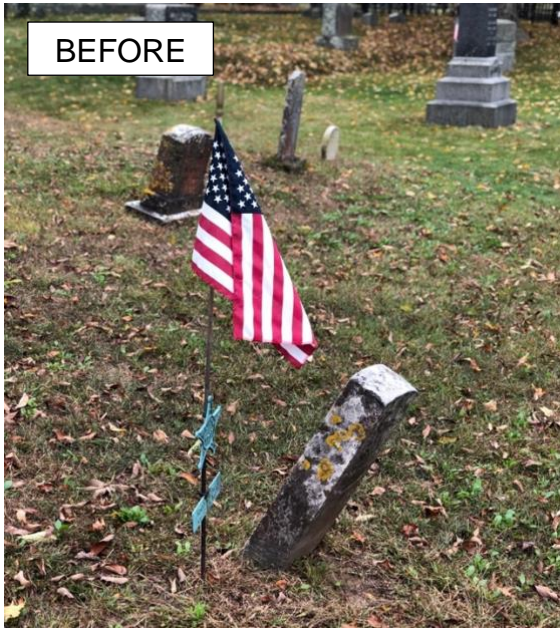
4) TURNER FAMILY STONES: Restoration Cost = \$3,750



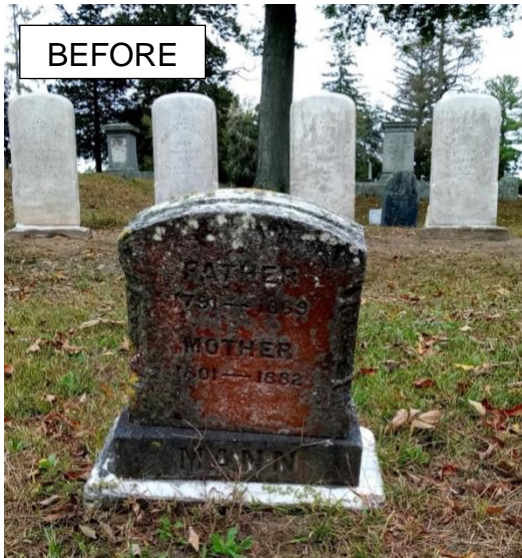
4) TURNER FAMILY BURIAL PLOT: Restoration Cost = \$7,150

7) STEPHEN BENSON SLATE STONE: Restoration Cost = \$550

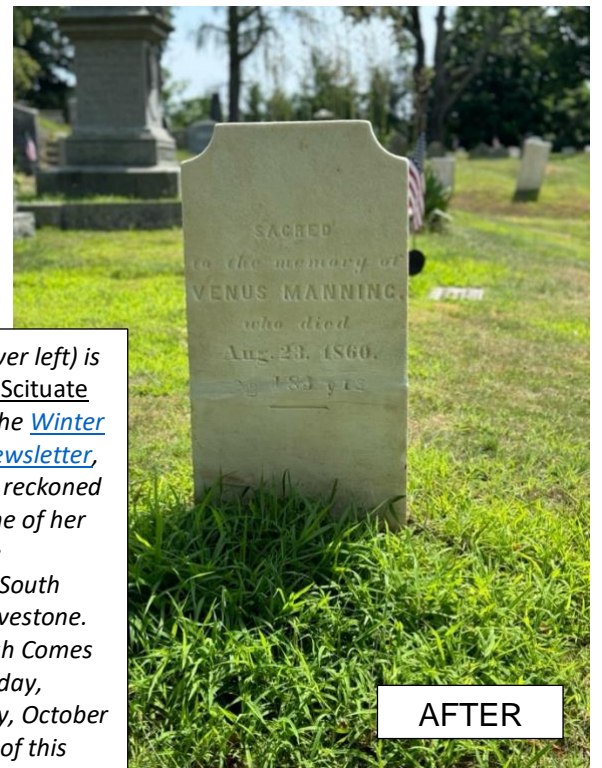
8) FRANCIS KENNEDY MARBLE STONE: Restoration Cost = \$800

This photo of Venus Manning (lower left) is from the Merritt History of South Scituate and Norwell book. As profiled in the Winter 2022 Norwell Historical Society newsletter, Venus Manning was a force to be reckoned with in South Scituate. "At the time of her 1860 death, she was amongst the wealthiest women in the town of South Scituate...", hence the marble gravestone. At the start of the 2024 First Parish Comes Alive! Cemetery Tour (date: Saturday, October 26th and raindate: Sunday, October 27th), there will be a rededication of this stone to honor this important woman in South Scituate/Norwell history.
