		Two letters of recommendation addressed to the Caen Scholarship Committee. O At least one letter should be from a French teacher. Caen Scholarship Letter of Recommendation Forms (included in this packet) should be attached to each letter.
		Evaluation of French Language Proficiency Form.
		Current photo of yourself: make sure it is a close-up, like the one you would have for a driver's license

Caen Scholarship Program General Information

Purpose:

The purpose of the Caen Scholarship Program is to provide the opportunity for an education abroad experience at the University of Caen, allowing students the chance to improve in linguistic knowledge and gain international experience by studying for a semester at the University of Caen.

Requirements:

For applying:

- Student must be 18 years of age or older
- Student must have completed at least one year of college/university.
- Student must have a good knowledge of the language allowing them the ability to engage in classes conducted fully in French.
- Student must be willing to spend an entire semester in France.
- Must be interviewed and selected by Sister Cities Committee

Upon selection:

- Attend two orientations:
 - One after acceptance and one before departure for France.
- Comply with the instructions given by the Education Abroad advisor in order to obtain student visa and other documents in a timely manner.
 - o This includes:
 - Maintaining communication with the University of Kentucky Education Abroad,
 Lexington Sister Cities, and the Deauville Jumelage during each step in the process.
 - Completing the proper materials in a timely manner for the UKEA Application, University of Caen application, as well as your Campus France application and visa papers.

Provided to the Student:

Participants in the Caen Scholarship program will receive:

- Tuition
- Housing
 - Excluding housing deposit (refunded at end of semester)
- UK tuition & fees waiver

Tuition and housing provided to the student by the Deauville Twinning Committee.

Responsibility of Student:

Selected students are responsible for:

- Roundtrip airfare to France
- Transportation from Paris to Caen (methods of transportation will be discussed at orientations)
- Housing Deposit approximately 175 euro (refunded if dorm left in good condition and key is returned)
- Student Card approximately 190 euros
- Student Social Security 215 euros
- Travel Medical Insurance contact Education Abroad for cost
- UKEA application fee and administrative fee
- EAP 599 fee
- Campus France fee
- Travel to and from the French consulate in Chicago
- Any fees for obtaining your visa
- Meals
- Submissions to the Lexington Sister Cities Blog
- Thank you letter to Deauville Twinning Committee upon completion of program
