#### **Submission Guidelines**

DEADLINE: March 20th, 2020

Sister Cities International aims to promote peace through mutual respect, understanding, and cooperation – one individual, one community at a time. This year's theme, "One World: Out of Many, We are One," showcases the importance of travel and exchange in achieving peace.

This year's theme asks students to explore these questions by highlighting citizen diplomacy and the creative ways that we create peace through people-to-people interaction.

- How can internationally engaged future leaders help communities address global challenges of social unity and peace – in the 21st century?
- How does international experience affect an individual or community's ability to adapt?
- What are some examples/illustrations of coming together and celebrating our humanity?

#### **Category & Specifications:**

Categories: Essay or Poetry

- o Essays are not to exceed 500 woods, and poetry is not to exceed 25 lines.
- o Entries must be in English.
- Judges will evaluate entries based on theme interpretation, composition, and grammar.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed per participant.

All work must be original and inspired by the theme. Entries may not be plagiarized, stolen, or copied from other sources.

#### **Entries:**

Each participating student artist must be between 13 and 18 years of age by the deadline. All entries must be the original work of the entrant. Students must submit their work to Lexington Sister Cities by March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Lexington Sister Cities will then submit the works to Sister Cities International in Washington D.C. by April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020, the international deadline.

#### **International Competition:**

A first place winner will be selected from both the poetry and essay categories. Each first place winner will receive \$1,000 CASH. Second and third place winners will also be selected from the poetry and essay categories.

The six (6) winning entries will be published on the Sister Cities International website and displayed at the 2020 Annual Conference in Washington, D.C.
