The 33rd Annual Young Artists Competition "United in Hope" <u>Submission Guidelines</u> DEADLINE: Friday, March 19, 2021

Theme:

The COVID-19 pandemic is a unique phenomenon in that it has affected every country around the globe. However, as is common in tragedy, hope shines through for those who persevere. <u>Hope is a uniting force during this time</u> as people struggle to cope with its ongoing effects and once again start to imagine a life without social distancing or wearing a mask. Indeed, the younger generation is capable of dreaming of a human existence that is even more dynamic, more advanced, and more resilient than ever before.

Students should explore the following questions through the lens of citizen diplomacy and include creative ways that we stand together looking toward the future.

How can the next generation of citizen diplomats help communities respond during and after the pandemic? In what ways does international experience affect an individual or community's ability to stay hopeful? What are some examples or illustrations of coming together and celebrating our hope in humanity and its future? What are some unique ways that your city, country, or culture has proven to be hopeful during the past year?

Medium & Specifications:

- Only two dimensional (2D), unframed artwork.
- Media accepted include oil, acrylic, watercolor, charcoal, colored pencil, crayon, ink, marker, etching, collage. (Photography is a separate category. Application can be found with your teacher or on the Lexington Sister Cities website, <u>www.lexingtonsistercities.org</u>)
- Use of copyrighted or trademarked images is prohibited.
- Entries <u>must not be plagiarized, stolen, or copied from any other source</u>. Entries must not defame or invade the rights of any person, living or dead.

Entries:

Each participating student artist must be between 13 and 18 years of age by April 1, 2021. All entries must be the original design and artwork of the entrant. Only new pieces inspired by the theme should be submitted.

This year, we will not be accepting physical artwork, only photographs of the artwork. Please confirm that photographs are not less than 180 dpi Email: lexingtonsistercities@gmail.com

Judging:

A panel will judge entries on the basis of originality, composition, and theme interpretation. Artist's name, title, description of work and name of school are kept confidential until judging has been completed. The judges' decision will be final.

Awards:

Local Competition: First, second, and third places will be chosen and cash prizes will be awarded by <u>Central Bank</u> to the students. 1st place will receive \$250, 2nd place - \$150, and third place - \$100. These top three pieces will be sent to Sister Cities International for the worldwide competition

International Competition: First, Second and Third place winners will be selected in the international competition. The Grand Prize Winner (first place) will receive \$1,000; 2nd place will receive \$250; and 3rd place will receive \$100. The winning art pieces will be published on the Sister Cities International website.
