# Lexington – Newmarket Student Exchange Program

Thank you for your interest in the 2022 Summer Student Exchange Program to Newmarket, England. The purpose of this exchange program is to provide genuine cultural and family experiences in another country for students of Lexington, Kentucky and those of Newmarket, England.

Student and parents/guardians must be willing and able to receive a British student in their home for the same length of time that an American student is in England. This is an exact exchange, meaning that once students are matched with their international counterpart, they will be together for both parts of the exchange program in England and in Lexington.

To be selected for a Lexington Sister Cities student exchange program, applicants should exhibit maturity, flexibility, an interest in British culture, and qualities that would make them a good ambassador for Lexington, Kentucky and the United States of America.

Students must turn 13 by July 1, 2022 to participate in the program. **Please note that students over the age of 18 before August 1, 2022 will not be considered for this program.**

## **Applications are due to Lexington Sister Cities Friday, November 5, 2021.**

  - Recommendation letters may be turned in separate from the application if necessary, and can be emailed to [lexingtonsistercities@gmail.com](mailto:lexingtonsistercities@gmail.com). Letters should be received by the application deadline on Friday, November 5, 2021.

At the end of this application, you can find “Frequently Asked Questions” that explain the timeline and cost of the program. Please review this before submitting your application. After the application deadline, an interview date will be set up for candidates and parents. Our main form of communication is through email, so please ensure that all student and parent emails are accurate. Upon acceptance into the program, orientations will be held to prepare students for the exchange. **Orientations are mandatory for participation.**

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# Lexington – Newmarket Student Exchange Program

## Frequently Asked Questions:

### 1. How long is the exchange?

- a. Lexington students travel to Newmarket for 10-12 days during the summer, and Newmarket students travel to Lexington for 7-10 days in the fall.

### 2. What are the dates for the exchange?

- a. While we do not have exact dates for the exchange, we can give some approximate time frames. Lexington students may travel to England sometime between the end of June through the end of July. Newmarket students usually visit Lexington around the end of October.

### 3. Is there a chaperone for the students?

- a. Yes. The chaperone is usually a teacher or member of Lexington Sister Cities. They will be available at orientations for parents and students to meet and get to know.

### 4. Who will my student stay with during the exchange?

- a. Your student will be matched with a student from Newmarket, who will be their host family while in England; however, students will stay as a group, with the chaperone, at the British Racing School.

### 5. How are the host families in Newmarket selected?

- a. The Sister Cities Committee in Newmarket (called the “Lexington Link”) selects their host families in a similar process to ours. Because Newmarket is a much smaller town and there is only one school, the committee members usually know the families well even before selection.

### 6. How much does the exchange cost?

- a. Other than the \$25 application fee, the cost will be between \$1,700 and \$1,900, depending on current airline prices. Once accepted, a \$200 non-refundable deposit is due to Lexington Sister Cities at the first orientation. If necessary, payment plans can be arranged. However, the full amount of the airline ticket will be due at least 90 days from departure. Scholarships are available for financial need – the scholarship application can be found on the website.

### 7. What are some other costs we may incur?

- a. Other costs for the students include spending money for gifts, souvenirs, et cetera; as well as obtaining a passport if they do not have one already.

### 8. When are the interviews for the exchange?

- a. Interviews will be scheduled either mid-November or early December. Interviews will only last about 30 minutes per family. Both parents should make every effort to attend the interview with their student, at least one parent or guardian is required to attend.

### 9. What happens after my student gets selected?

- a. The Lexington-Newmarket Committee will inform the student and their parents at the interview when the acceptances will be emailed out to the students. Once the student receives their acceptance email, they will be given a date to accept their spot in the program. This date is usually 24-48 hours after the acceptance email is sent.
- b. Once students have accepted their spot in the program, a \$200 non-refundable deposit is required to be turned in by the first program orientation. This deposit goes towards your airfare.

- c. Monthly orientations will start in February. **ORIENTATIONS ARE MANDATORY** for participation in the program. At least one parent should attend each meeting with their student.

### **10. What is provided to my student while they are in England?**

- a. While your student is in England, accommodation will be provided by the British Racing School, and meals will be provided by the host family. Exceptions may include if the students are out together and they get ice cream/coffee/etc. This would be something your student would use spending money for.

### **11. What are we expected to provide for the Newmarket student while they are in Lexington?**

- a. While the Newmarket student is in Lexington, you are expected to provide meals and accommodations. Treat them as an additional child in your family – anything you would pay for your own child, you should pay for the Newmarket student as well.

### **12. What if my student gets sick while in England?**

- a. Just as you would care for a sick child in your home, so will your student's host family. We ask that you check with your insurance company before your child departs to make sure you are covered for international expenses.

### **13. Are there group activities planned by Sister Cities?**

- a. Yes – both in England and in Lexington the committees plan groups activities and dinners.

### **14. Can my child drive while in England?**

- a. No.

### **15. Can my child drive their Newmarket student while in Lexington?**

- a. Yes, if they have a valid driver's license that permits them to drive others in his/her car.

### **16. Can I call/email/text my child while they are in England?**

- a. Yes – BUT we prefer that this is done only occasionally.

### **17. How does the committee decide how to match the students?**

- a. We gather information from both applications and the Lexington student's interview to try and match based on: common interests, age & gender (if you have specified you cannot host a student of the opposite gender, you will not be expected to), and other specifications such as pet allergies.

### **18. My child is hoping their counterpart will end up being their best friend. Is this the case?**

- a. While many great, lasting friendships have been made on our exchange programs, not every match is perfect. Both committees do their best to match the students, but sometimes the students do not end up being best friends. However, they are both still provided with a great opportunity to have a cultural experience that they should take advantage of, regardless of their similarities to their counterpart.
