 Two Letters of Recommendation One letter should be from a French teacher/instructor/tutor. Second letter can be from a teacher, counselor, advisor, or personal reference. Caen Scholarship Letter of Recommendation Forms should be attached to each letter. These forms are located at the end of this application packet.

Caen Scholarship Program General Information

Purpose:

In partnership with the University of Kentucky and Deauville Jumelage, the purpose of the Caen Scholarship Program is to provide the opportunity for an education abroad experience, allowing you the chance to improve in linguistic knowledge and gain international experience by studying for a semester at the University of Caen.

Requirements:

- You must be 18 years of age or older
- You must have completed at least one year of college/university
- You must be enrolled in full-time status at University of Kentucky
- You must have minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at time of application and participation
- You must have a good knowledge of the French language allowing you the ability to engage in classes conducted fully in French
- You must be willing to spend an entire semester in France
- You must be interviewed and selected by the Lexington Sister Cities Committee

Upon selection:

- You must attend two orientations:
 - One after acceptance and one before departure for France.
- You must comply with the instructions given by the UK Education Abroad & Exchanges advisor in order to obtain student visa and other documents in a timely manner.
 - o This includes:
 - Maintaining communication with the University of Kentucky Education Abroad & Exchanges advisor, Lexington Sister Cities, and the Deauville Jumelage during each step of the process.
 - Completing the proper materials in a timely manner for the UKEA Application, University of Caen application, as well as your Campus France application and visa papers.

Provided to you:

Applicants selected to participate in the Caen Scholarship program will receive:

- Tuition
- Housing (excluding housing deposit)
- UK tuition & fees waiver (excluding EAP599 tuition fee)

Tuition and housing provided to the student by the Deauville Twinning Committee.

Your Responsibilities:

Applicants selected to participate in the Caen Scholarship Program are responsible for:

- Roundtrip airfare to France
- Transportation from Paris to Caen (transportation options will be discussed during orientation)
- Housing Deposit approximately 175 euro (refunded if dorm left in good condition and key is returned)
- Student Card approximately 190 euros
- Student Social Security 215 euros
- Travel Medical Insurance contact Education Abroad & Exchanges for cost
- UKEA application fee and administrative fee
- EAP 599 fee
- Campus France fee
- Travel to and from visa interview appointment with VFS Global in Chicago, Illinois
- Any fees for obtaining your visa
- Meals for the entire length of stay in France
- Thank You letter to the Deauville Twinning Committee upon completion of program
