






ARTIST SUPPORT GRANT

RSAF again participated in the Artist Support Grant allocation process. Grants were awarded in Craft, Dance, Film, Literature, Media Arts, Music, Photography and Visual Arts to artists in Alexander, Burke, Caldwell, Catawba, Iredell and Mc-Dowell Counties to advance their artistic levels.
