### By submitting this registration form, I agree & understand the following:

1. Artist check-in and required stamping of canvas or other art surfaces is from 9am – 5pm at the Old Rock School on September 19 and from 9-12pm on September 20, 400 Main Street West, Valdese, NC 28690.
2. Awards: All participating artists can select one of their masterpieces to be entered to win prizes: 1st - \$500 plus an exhibition in the RSAF gallery, 2nd - \$250, 3rd - \$125, People's choice - \$75
3. I agree that canvas or other surface used for artwork submitted for judging or sale must bear the stamp of the event.
4. I may submit two pieces for display, one of which must be identified as the piece to be judged.
5. The piece I submit for judging will feature a subject painted in the Town of Valdese (publicly accessible areas only), Valdese Lakeside Park<sup>1</sup> or McGalliard Falls Park during the dates of the event: September 19<sup>th</sup> – September 20<sup>th</sup> (daylight hours only).
6. The piece I submit for judging will be painted in oil, acrylic, watercolor, gouache, or pastel.
7. I will display name, medium(s) title and pricing information on artwork that is submitted.
8. I will submit my artwork for display and judging between the hours of 5pm – 8pm on Saturday, September 20<sup>th</sup>, to the Rock School Arts Foundation at the Old Rock School.
9. I will pay my \$35 registration fee with this registration form. Make checks payable to Rock School Arts Foundation and remit with application.
10. Commission of 20% will be charged for each piece of artwork sold.
11. I agree to the waiver and release of liability:

I will abide by all Town of Valdese, Valdese Lakeside Park and Valdese public facility rules and regulations. Failure to do so may result in suspension from the facility and event without refund/credit. I agree and represent on behalf of myself and my invited guests that use of all facilities shall be undertaken at each participant's own risk. I release from liability Friends of the Valdese Rec., Rock School Arts Foundation, and the Town of Valdese for any claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions or causes of action during my participation, or that of my invited friends or family, in connection with the Valdese Plein Air Fest event. I release Rock School Arts Foundation for any damages due to faulty framing or hanging devices on my artwork.

12. I agree that Rock School Arts Foundation has the right to determine display location for the exhibit and has the right to reject a painting for any reason.
13. I agree to permit the use of photographs of me and my invited guests taken during the event to be used in physical and electronic media, as long as any images of my artwork are not of sufficient resolution to be reproduced.
