I am writing to address an incident that took place during, and after, the most recent SWAG community meeting on Monday 01/14/25 involving the President of the Churchill Downs Neighborhood Association; Jacquese West.

During a discussion about the plans for the development at Holmes and Pleasant Grove much of the conversation focused on the Malcolm X memorial part of the project. During this conversation my husband; Mike Lynn Jr. voiced that there are far too many Black voices missing from the conversations up to this point, and that SWAG may not be best suited to be the conveners of the community with this as a priority. Mike is very dedicated and vocal on centering Black voices in plans, policies, anything that involves or could impact the Black community.
