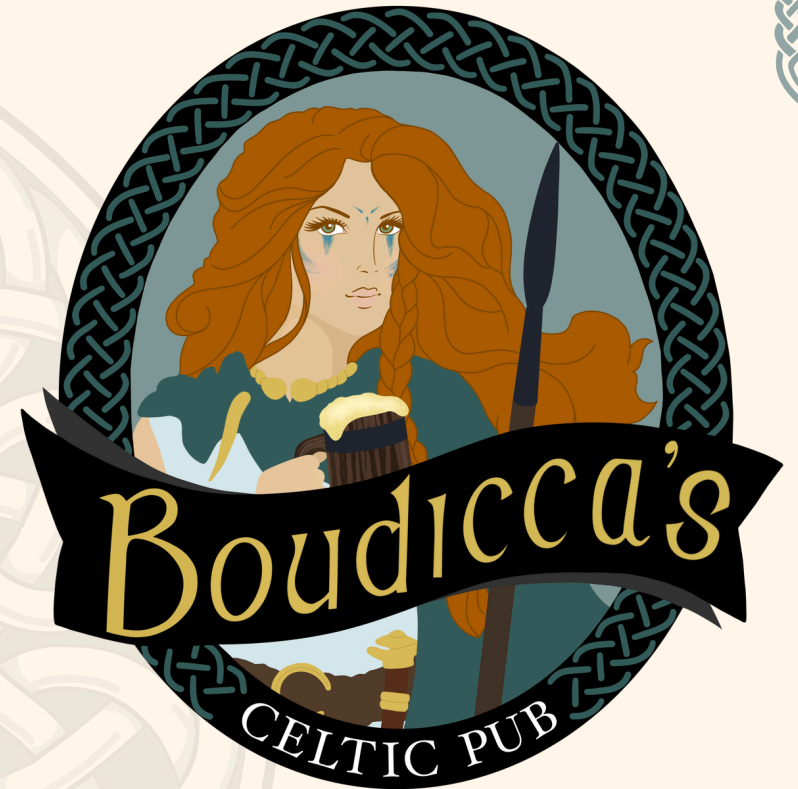


# About Boudicca

Due to gross mistreatment during Rome's second military campaign to conquer Briton and being driven by their intense hatred of the veterans who drove them out of their homes to be captives and slaves, Boudicca led a revolt of unified tribes against the Romans. She was queen of the Celtic Iceni tribe and made to suffer unspeakable abuses to her person, endure the violation of her two daughters and abide confiscation of their tribal wealth.

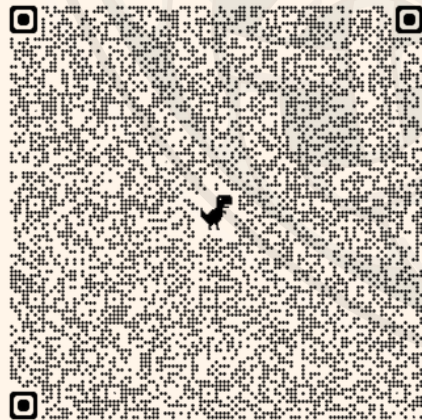
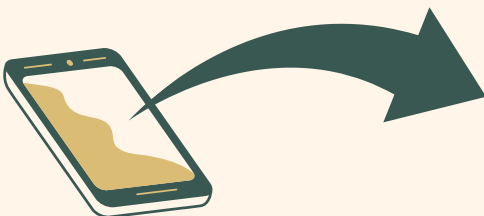
Out of greed, Rome fabricated a war opposing its own governing ally in order to take the Iceni territory for themselves and eventually, ended Boudicca's rebellion with the superior strategies of the 9th Legion. However, not before her uprising led to 80,000 Roman deaths and burned three cities to the ground, including London!

Thanks to Queen Victoria of England (the Victorian era) and Prince Albert, Boudicca became a Celtic Folk Hero. Queen Victoria adopted Boudicca as her 'namesake' (both names share identical meanings), an act which produced statues, busts, poems, songs, paintings, stained glass, plays and various other art forms paying tribute to Boudicca, the Warrior Queen!
