Paramount Academy will identify, locate, and evaluate all children with disabilities within their population served who are in need of special education and related services. In its identification process Paramount Academy will include children who are suspected of being a child with a disability and in need of special education.

(34 C.F.R. 300.111)

Paramount Academy will inform the general public and parents within its population served of the responsibility for the special education services for students age 3-21 years, and how those services may be accessed including information regarding early information services for children age birth through 5 years. Services for an eligible student with a disability shall extend through conclusion of the instructional year during which the student attains the age of 22.

(A.A.C. R7-2-401.C)

Paramount Academy will require all staff members to review the written procedures related to child identification and referral on an annual basis, and maintain documentation of the staff review.

(A.A.C. R7-2-401.D)

Identification screening for possible disabilities shall be completed within 45 calendar days after:

- Entry of each pre-school or kindergarten student and any student enrolling without appropriate records or screening, evaluation, and progress in our school; or
- Parent notification of developmental or education concerns

If you have a concern with a child between the ages of birth to 5 years please notify the school receptionist for information.
