Making the Grade is a free supplemental program funded using the Title I grant that was created to help students meet the Arizona College and Career Readiness Standards. Guidelines for identification for this program include, but are not limited to, standardized testing from previous school years, current progress or report card grades, and teacher recommendations.

Making the Grade consists of two independent programs in the subject areas of Math and Reading. Both programs will focus on lessons from our supplemental Math and ELA curriculum, which are designed to align with the State and Federal Standards in both Math and Reading. Students in this program will work on mini lessons designed to align with their regular classroom curriculum.

The Making the Grade program takes place after school and typically with the homeroom teacher. Both the Math and Reading programs are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15pm until 4:15pm.

Annual Schedule:

Making the Grade (Semester 1): Week after Labor Day until the second week of December

Making the Grade (Semester 2): Week after returning from Winter Break until the end of April
