Taunton Motoring Club – Best All Rounder Championship 2025

The championship is organised to encourage Taunton Motoring Club (TMC) members to participate in and contribute to the running of TMC events and to recognise one person who has an outstanding performance in the year.

The championship will run from 1st January to 10th December. Awards will be presented at the annual Christmas meal and award presentation and are as follows: 1st place - a perpetual trophy, award & Demon Tweeks voucher for £50; 2nd place – award & £20 DT voucher; 3rd place – award & £10 DT voucher.

Only TMC members can score points and only on events run by ASWMC member clubs. Competitors will enter under TMC (where a club is specified). Every competitor must score points in at least one of the categories in Section 3 to be classified. Points can be scored in up to 5 events for each category in Sections 1 and 2.

There is no need to register for the championship, but proof of current TMC membership will be required. Zak Linham will act as Championship co-ordinator and will keep a tally of scores. Competitors will need to claim points no more than 30 days after the scoring event by emailing Zak on: zlinhamrally@gmail.com. Organisers of TMC events will submit scores to Zak within a week of the event.

Disputes will be resolved by a panel consisting of the championship co-ordinator, the TMC Chairman/Vice Chairman plus 3 other committee members.
