COMPLIANCE ACTIONS REQUESTED
By Deadline March 1, 2026

The EIN 81-2980752 has been terminated by the IRS, with dissolution of any associated entity occurring on November 19, 2025. Final Form 990 which includes a five-year self-audit, will be submitted to the IRS for the terminated EIN 81-2980752, by IRS deadline of April 1, 2026.

This is formal notice for any outstanding financial documents. Any individual has until deadline of March 1, 2026, to deliver any financial documents to the Liquidator Fred Simon which implicates the EIN 81-2980752 in the transaction during the year 2025.

All records submitted will go directly to the Liquidator, and integrated into the Form 990. If there is any indication that theft occurred, these records may be given to the Attorney General's office as safeguard against prosecution of vetted Tribal Registry members who had no knowledge that their identity was being used in an illegal manner.

Notice to any individual, or individuals in group-agreement, who persist in the use of this EIN 81-2980752 after the termination date of November 19, 2025, or who has withheld financial records pertaining to the year 2025 which should be included in the Final IRS Form 990 report: **Legal penalties will fall upon such persons without any legal protection from Natchitoches Tribe of Louisiana 501c3 Nonprofit Corporation (NTL-NC)**, the designated asset holder of dissolved EIN 81-2980752. When such withheld financial documents are discovered (as some have been), then such information will be promptly turned over to the Louisiana Attorney General's office for prosecution of public fraud of use of a terminated IRS EIN number and false representation of a 501c3 entity.

COMPLIANCE ACTIONS REQUESTED By Deadline March 1, 2026

Number One. Identification of all donations, fundraising, and grant applications made since December, 2024, and handled under the Tribal Council (excluding the legal NTL-NC Treasurer's record-keeping), and using the EIN 81-2980752. All records and documents relating to such financial transactions are to be transferred to the Liquidator, Fred Simon. This “cease and desist” applies specifically to any individual who identifies themselves as the “Treasurer” of Natchitoches Tribe of Louisiana. Any such financial items not turned over will be immediately referred to the State Attorney General's office upon discovery of such withheld financial information.

Number Two. Cease and Desist in any donation programs which use the EIN 81-2980752. Any such donations made in 2025 and diverted to a bank account set up fraudulently under this EIN or a false EIN or personal social security number not related to this entity being dissolved, unless submitted to the Liquidator to be included in this legal dissolution, will be individually, or by group, investigated by IRS when the EIN shows up as being used by any other entity. This type of donation includes programs such as Amazon, Walmart, or other public choice donation programs. Even though the individual(s) who initially set up these accounts may still have access to such accounts, this is to inform you that such programs can only be terminated (or transferred) by those individuals who set them up. As Liquidator, I implore you to send me all the sign-in information so that I, as Liquidator, can fulfill the legal duty of deleting these accounts. On those accounts which I am prohibited from accessing, as I do not have such sign-in information, please carefully consider your legal penalties for continuing to divert such funds to another receiving account. If these funds are not included in the final Form 990 five-year audit, remember that your personal information is still identifiable via the donation portal, and that this donation program is required to turn over any such information to IRS as part of their audit process. These donations portals will be reported in the five-year audit schedule and as being possibly active and diverting of public donations.

Number Three. Cease and Desist immediately all activities which are identified as “for and on behalf of” the Natchitoches Tribe of Louisiana “unincorporated association” (whether or not you identify as an “unincorporated association” or as a Louisiana-State Recognized Tribe) upon receipt of this letter. Proof of delivery of the “Cease and Desist” notice will be by various means, as permitted by the Attorney General’s guidelines: registered mail, known e-mail addresses, posting on NTL-NC websites, social media posts and re-posts, telephone notification, etc.

Number Four. All assets of the dissolved entity under EIN 81-2980752 have been legally transferred to Natchitoches Tribe of Louisiana 501c3 Nonprofit Corporation (NTL-NC). All individuals who wish to remain engaged in legitimate activities on behalf of the legally identified Natchitoches Tribe of Louisiana Nonprofit 501c3 Corporation (NTL-NC) are required to submit Volunteer Applications as described on website: <https://natchitochestribeoflouisiana.us>

These volunteers will be initiated into appropriate committees under the direction of the Board of Directors of NTL-NC as legally required by the State of Louisiana Nonprofit Corporation Laws. There is no timeline on this registration; however, if any activities are continued and/or resumed under EIN 81-2980752 by any individual (or group) outside of this legal process, they will be immediately reported to the Louisiana State Attorney General's office for violation of Nonprofit Corporation law and public financial fraud laws, as well as reported to the appropriate IRS officials.
