

REFLECTIONS FROM FR. MATTHEW

“The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, will teach you everything”

In today’s gospel Jesus continues to speak reassuring words about love. He knows the unspoken questions in the hearts of his disciples. How we will be able to do what we heard Jesus tell us last Sunday: love one another as he has loved us? “Whoever loves me will keep my word,” says Jesus, and this word is what he has received from the Father who sent him. He is now in our hearts, to be loved freely, without compulsion.

Jesus knows very well how difficult that will be for us. We are weak and we will fail. Even with all our good intentions we struggle to live according to the will of God. Knowing this Jesus tells us, “Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid”. And then he promises us that he will send the Holy Spirit to assist us in our desire to live according to God’s will and love as he loved us. **“The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you.”**

The disciples, even after the many encounters they had with the risen Lord, were still afraid, confused, doubtful and scattered. That’s why Jesus promises to send an Advocate or intercessor who will remind the disciples of everything that Jesus taught them and bring them peace. They gathered with Mary, praying and waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit. As they received the Holy Spirit, they grasped and understood everything Jesus taught them.

The same “**Paraclete**,” translated also as “encourager,” “advocate,” “counselor” is with us today reminding us and teaching us about the mysteries of salvation revealed to us through Jesus Christ. Like the disciples let us desire and pray for the Holy Spirit to fill us and renew us in our faith.

As our celebration of the Easter season is coming to an end, the liturgy reminds us that Jesus remains with us through the Holy Spirit, who teaches us everything we need to know, reminds us of all that Jesus taught, and brings us peace. This Peace is *shalom*, the right relationship that flows from our loving union with God through Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
