2,636 People

Of these numbers most are on Food Share, many are over the age of 60 and the number of new families with children is growing.

In that same time span our Volunteers logged well over 2,000 hours at the pantry and in pantry related tasks.




MPH Helping Hands



Barb's Baby Ministry



Begun in the basement of parishioner Barb Kiernan (who handed this on to MPH after passing away from cancer), this ministry works primarily with health clinics, social workers, hospitals, nurses, and schools as well as several other agencies.

We provide baskets for families with newborns, and bags for toddlers and other children in the family. Baskets contain diapers, wipes, toiletry items, new and gently used clothing, blankets, bibs and toys. Bags usually contain new & gently used clothing with a blanket and age-appropriate toy or book.
