#### **Celebrating the Sacraments**








#### 50th Anniversary of Ordination

# Did You Know...



Currently we have St. Vincent de Paul Parish Conferences at all 3 of our Parishes, IHM, MQH and St. Al's. As of July 1 they will be combined into a single *Mother of Perpetual Help* Parish Conference. Currently St. Al's and IHM operate Food Pantries. St. Al's is open once a month. MQH has a "Loaves and Fishes" program where they make 6-7 food deliveries a month. IHM's Food Pantry is supported by Hunger Task Force as well as SVDP and our parish because of the large numbers served. Members of all 3 conferences make Home Visits to people in need in our communities. Members of the IHM conference support the SVDP Meal Program on the south side of Milwaukee by providing both food and volunteers every 5th Friday and 5th Sunday. Any parishioner is welcome to help with this! We welcome all who may be interested!

#### Here are a few statistics for the IHM Conference for the 6 months of October, 2017 to March, 2018:

- We have 15 Full-time Members and 10 Associate Members.
- Meetings are held twice a month. At these meetings in addition to business, we pray for our parish, special
  needs including those in the prayer box we have out at the pantry for patrons, our families, and all those we
  serve.
- We made 35 home visits in addition to visits to senior and other care centers where we provide a listening ear along with goods, services, and communion when requested.
- We served over 1,200 guests at the South Side Meal program and provided casseroles, milk and jello for those 1,200+ guests at the South Side Meal program.

WITH YOUR GENEROUS SUPPORT, and Meijer's Simply Give program, in those 6 months we were able to:

- Serve 762 households (1,654 people) at our Food Pantry (families receive nonperishable food for 3 days—1-2
  bags depending on the size of the household, plus meat, bread and extras); deliver food to about 5-6 households
  each month;
- · Provide to over 75 families, full Easter Meal boxes complete with hams;
- Provide to over 75 families, full Thanksgiving Meal boxes which included turkeys and all the fixings;
- Provide over 80 full Meal boxes to families at Christmas which included hams and all the fixings;
- · Provide gift packages for about 50 children at Christmas.

Our volunteers logged 1,271 hours and 3,022 miles in those 6 months as well!

If any of this looks to be of interest to you, please consider coming and helping out at our Food Pantry (open every Saturday 9:30-11:30 am, the last Wednesday of the month 6-7:30 pm and all other Wednesdays 9-11:00 am) or join us to make jello, help to make a casserole or volunteer to serve at the South Side Meal Program (5th Fridays and Sundays). 
