Celebrating the Sacraments

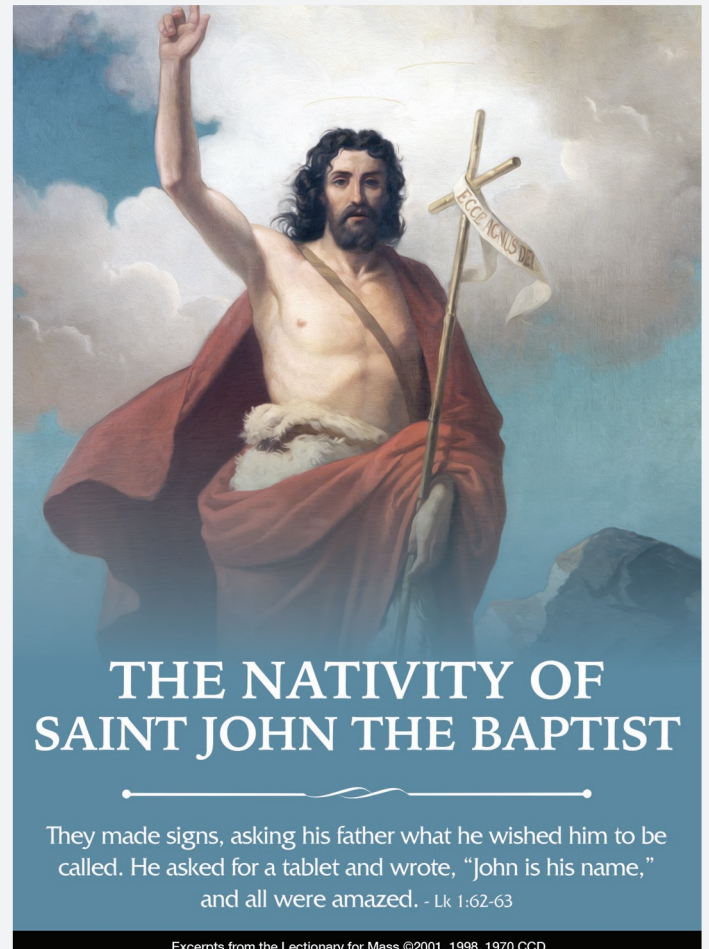
Baptism is celebrated during or after Mass on the First Sunday of the month at Immaculate Heart of Mary; on the Second Sunday of the month at Mary Queen of Heaven and on the Fourth Sunday of the month at St. Aloysius. Other times may be arranged by calling one of the priests. A Baptismal preparation class is required. Please call the Tri-parish office to find out the times and locations of class and to register your child.

Confession is celebrated on the First Saturday of the month at 8:30 am at St. Aloysius; on the First and Second Saturday of the month at 3:00 pm at Immaculate Heart of Mary and on the Third and Fourth Saturdays of the month at 3:30 pm at Mary Queen of Heaven.

Anointing of the Sick is celebrated communally on the First Saturday of the month after the 4:30 pm Mass at Mary Queen of Heaven; on the First Saturday of the month after the 4:00 pm Mass at Immaculate Heart of Mary and on the Second Sunday of the month after the 10:30 am Mass at St. Aloysius. Individual anointing may be requested after any parish Mass or by calling one of the parish priests.

Weddings Please call the Tri-Parish office to make arrangements no later than 6 months prior to your anticipated date. A process of preparation including participation in an Archdiocesan Engaged Encounter is required of all couples seeking marriage in the church.

FROM THE PASTORS' DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In a week, we will all become part of Mother of Perpetual Help Parish. We have been working together for this moment for a long time. Even though much has been accomplished, there is still much to do. One of our first tasks has been to eliminate duplication among the three parish sites. Some changes that will take place immediately are the following:

-As of **July 1st**, the Parish name is “**Mother of Perpetual Help Parish, West Allis.**” The three former parish names will no longer be in use as those parishes will have been suppressed by the Archdiocese and their legal status as separate incorporations dissolved.

-As we continue to operate the three sites for the time being, they will be called “**MPH 92nd Street**”, “**MPH 106th Street**” and “**MPH 116th Street**”. It will take us a while to get used to this, but it is the easiest way to distinguish between the three sites.

-The parish office address is **1121 South 116th Street, West Allis, Wisconsin, 53214**. The office is located at the 116th Street Site.

-The main parish telephone number is **(414) 453-5192**.

While these changes may seem simple, even obvious, it will take us some time to get used to them. We pray for patience and understanding as we continue to discover who we are called to be as the new Mother of Perpetual Help Parish.

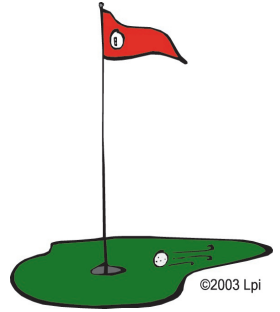
