Mother of Perpetual Site Meetings

Part of the process of merging into one parish is to answer the question; "Will we ever be located at one site?"

The first two meetings to discuss this possibility will be held on Thursday, September 6th at 6:30 PM at the 106th street site in the Gym, and again on Saturday, September 8th at 10:00 AM in Gonzaga Hall at the 92nd Street site.

At these meetings you will be invited to view and discuss possible plans for each site as we try to discern the answer to the question. There will be a graphic presentation and you will be given a link to "walk through" each proposal at your leisure using your home computer.

Hard copies of the presentations will also be available for each meeting. An additional meeting will be scheduled at the 116th Site in the next several weeks.

Dr. Mario Joseph

Mario Joseph (originally named Sulaiman) was born to a Muslim family in 1978 in the state of Kerala, India. At the age of eight, he joined Darusalam Arabic College for his religious studies and at the age of thirteen started to preach about Islam. When he was ordained as a Muslim cleric at the age of eighteen, he was one of the youngest clerics in Islam. His search to find out who Jesus Christ was began with the Muslim holy book, the Quran. It was from the holy Quran itself that he recognized the divinity of Jesus.

He studied the Holy Bible at the Divine Bible College and Bedezda Bible College in India. He completed his Master of Arts in Religion and Philosophy from Madurai Kamaraj University, India. He is also the author of several books. For the last few years he has been preaching in seven different languages at the Divine Retreat Center, Kerala to approximately 10,000 retreatants every week, where he lives with his wife, Gigi, and two daughters, Adona and Abiyah. Additionally, he is a teacher of philosophy at Mary Matha Major Seminary and St. Joseph Seminary, Jeppu, and he conducts retreats for priests and religious.

Mario is very passionate about his faith and his testimony is dynamic, engaging and incredibly inspirational. We invite you to join us September 15th and 16th as we welcome him to Southeastern Wisconsin at Divine Mercy Parish, 800 Marquette Avenue in South Milwaukee, to hear his story and help us grow in our faith.

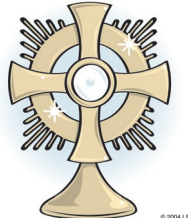
