#### **Celebrating the Sacraments**

<u>Baptism</u> is celebrated during or after Mass on the second and fourth Sunday of the month. Other times may be arranged by calling one of the priests. A Baptismal preparation class is required. Classes will be held quarterly in 2019, so it is recommended you schedule a class early, possibly before your child is born. Please call the parish office to register for the class and the Baptism.

Reconciliation (Confession) is celebrated on the First Saturday of the month at 8:30 am at the 92nd Street site and at 3:00 pm on the 116th Street site. On the Third Saturday of the month at 3:30 pm at the 106th Street site.

Anointing of the Sick is celebrated communally on the First Saturday of the month after the evening mass at the 106th and 116th Street sites. Individual anointing may be requested by calling one of the parish priests.

<u>Weddings</u> Please call the Parish office to make arrangements no later than 6 months prior to your anticipated date. A process of preparation including participation in an Archdiocesan Engaged Encounter is required of all couples seeking marriage in the church.

Dear Members of Mother of Perpetual Help Parish,

Many of you who know me well know that I take great pride in my parish; starting at St. Aloysius Gonzaga for the first 22 years of my life and then becoming MPH. We plan to have the choir, some brass, and also a ton of fun making music as we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family on that day. I hope to see all of you there and have a chance to say "see you later," because it really isn't "goodbye." You are always welcome to visit at Blessed Sacrament; and I know that you will always be here for me. It's with sincere gratitude that I thank you for your many years of support, especially to my original parish family of St. Aloysius Gonzaga.


