
MISSION STATEMENT

God's Word

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time/ August 29, 2021

A NOTE FROM FR. MATTHEW PERUMPIL, MI

After teaching us on "Bread of Life" for five weeks, Jesus now moves into a new direction to help us introspect our life as his disciples. Although He starts with the leaders of the Jewish community, he asks every disciple who likes to follow him to watch over "hypocrisy", quoting from the prophesy of Isaiah: "This people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me".

This is a powerful tool for introspection about how we worship and what happens to us, especially to our hearts. Are we becoming closer to the heart of Jesus as we come to worship him? Do we also become like the Pharisees and Scribes who became obsessed about the external practices and observances missing the "heart of the matter", becoming closer to the heart of Jesus and His love? Do our worship become encounters of loving God and loving one another?

Jesus continues to warn us to be careful of things that make us unclean from within. All those evil things we struggle to fight daily in our lives can be made clean by the generous mercy of our loving God. Every time we come to worship Him, he offers his generous mercy and grace to make us clean through His son Jesus Christ who shed his blood on the cross to redeem us.

The problem with the Pharisees were, they could not see they needed help from God. St. James in our second reading reminds us: "Humbly welcome the Word that has been planted in you and is able to save your souls. Be **doers of the Word and not hearers only**, deluding yourselves. Religion that is pure and undefiled before God and the Father is this: to care for orphans and widows in their affliction and to help oneself unstained by the world". (James 1:22, 27)

Let us pray for a clean heart, purified by the love of Christ and the love of neighbor.


Volunteer and Put a Smile on a Senior's Face!


