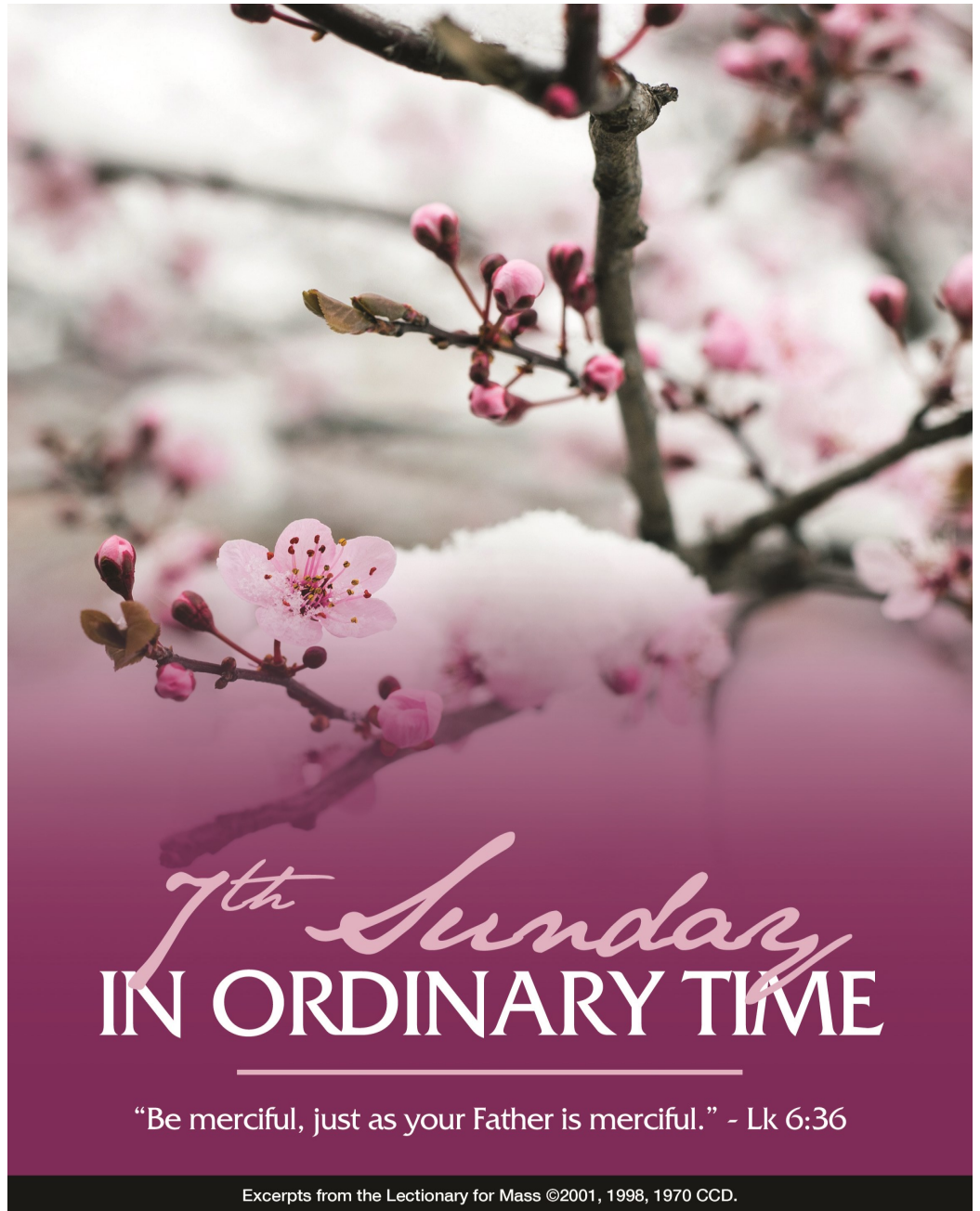

A NOTE FROM FR. MATTHEW

“Love your enemies...”

Today's gospel is a continuation of the teaching that began in last Sunday's gospel. We continue to hear Jesus' Sermon on the Plain. He teaches the disciples the radicality of being His disciple, constituting the crux and the challenge of what it means to be a disciple: *Love your enemies, turn the other cheek, give to those who ask, do unto others, lend without expecting repayment, judge not lest you be judged.* All of these exhortations are humanly hard to understand and definitely not easy to practice. Our natural question will be “How can I love someone who has hurt me? What does that mean?”

Maybe the problem is our understanding of what is love. The word “love” has become so wrapped up with our emotions; our passions, our feelings toward another person. Jesus isn't using the word love in the way that we would use it with the primary emphasis on a connotation of feelings.

First, “loving my enemies” entails good actions. So if I love an enemy, I will do good to someone who hates me. So even though they hate me, I don't return “eye for eye” or “tooth for tooth” but they give me evil and I return it with a good action. So the first way we show love for our enemies is to do good to them.

A second thing, if someone curses us, we are to bless them. A blessing is not just to do good towards somebody, but to speak good to somebody. So you bless with your mouth, you act with your actions through all kinds of different ways. So to bless is to verbalize a desire for good upon the person. So if someone curses me, I bless them. That's the second way to show them that I love them.

A third way is, “pray for those who mistreat you.” The prayer is for God to bless that person. You're asking for good to be done to someone who wishes harm to you; that is “loving your enemies”, praying for those who persecute you. It's not primarily rooted in the emotions. It's rooted in the will; it's rooted in the choices we make: to do good, to say good, and to pray for our enemies. Jesus concludes His exhortations by inviting us to “Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful”. Christian love is “*agapic*”, love that is self-giving and other-centered. The way of God is giving ourselves for others. May we have the courage to live this reality.

Becca Bojarski : Director of Religious Education

When anyone asks me about my job, I usually respond: “I’m a principal for Sunday School.” Why do I say this? I facilitate a wonderful committee that meets to plan and implement the program goals and expectations for the year. I recruit and oversee the volunteers who help in different capacities to make our program successful, including catechists, a class attendance coordinator, service project assistants, and our wonderful kitchen help when we are hosting a family event. I coordinate the schedules, service projects, stations of the cross, rehearsals, events, and sacraments. Over the years the program has grown and we see familiar faces returning, due to their immediate feeling of belonging to the MPH community.



I have worked with children since the age of 13. I have spent time as a Sunday School teacher, babysitter/nanny, preschool teacher, daycare provider, a before- and after-school director, and a summer camp counselor. In addition to my role at MPH, I find the time to teach specialty courses for the WAWM Rec Dept and recently substitute teaching in our own MQSCA school. I earned an Associates’ Degree in Early Childhood Education in my hometown in Pennsylvania and, here in Milwaukee, completed both a Bachelors’ Degree in Religious Studies and a Masters’ Degree in Lay Ministry from Cardinal Stritch University.

One of my favorite activities is to sing for funerals and weekend Masses, sharing God’s word through song, to uplift individuals in times of trial. I love spending time with my husband of 24 years and our three children ages 21, 14, and 7. We enjoy playing all sorts of table games together and going on vacation when we are able to take a break.

I am grateful to God for leading me here to MPH and thank all the parishioners who support our efforts of evangelizing new members of the faith for our Catholic future through our Religious Education Program.
