- 1. The meeting was called to order by Mary Maberry at 6:33 PM
- 2. Opening Prayer: Mary led the Mother of Perpetual Help Prayer
- 3. A motion to approve the Agenda was made by Darryl Draeger, seconded by Mary Lou Hopkins, and unanimously approved
- 4. Review of First Weekend Return to Mass
 - > Fr. Jeff provided the following:
 - 106th Street 4:00 PM 49/50 attendees; 8:00 AM 37/38 attendees; 11:00 AM 39 attendees; all but 1 wore mask in all 3 Masses
 - 116th Street 4:00 PM 38/39 attendees; 9:30 AM 36/38 attendees; most wore masks
 - 92nd Street 7:00 PM 45 attendees; most wore masks
 - 1-page Order of Worship available which was to be tossed or taken home
 - Discussion
 - Limited singing by members
 - Personal preference as to whether or not priests wear mask at homily
 - o Presider and cantors wearing masks sets a good example
 - o Announcement will be made regarding collection and communion process

5. Brief Financial Review

- Mary Wenger will send April financials to Council
- Fr. Jeff provided information on Marion termination; leaving all equipment, including cameras, whiteboards, screens, desks, etc.
- Seton will take over financial portion of school effective July 1, 2020
- Repair work ongoing

6. Council Elections

- Mary Maberry suggested doing Council nominations via web or mail
- Fr. Jeff stated no update has been received from Archdiocese
 - o Even with delayed elections terms will be treated effective as of June
 - o May be wise to move forward in the event there is another shutdown in fall
 - Issue of how to assure all have an opportunity to be nominated when 50% did not open the letters (with stamps) regarding Return to Mass
 - o Discussion suggestions made included robo calls, announcement before Mass

7. Parishioner Phone Calls

- Grace reported on the results of parishioner phone calls
 - A total of 300 calls were made (to all members without emails listed and eliminating those requesting phone numbers not published)
 - Volunteers left 114 voicemail messages
 - Received from Parishioners were the following:
 - Many requests for prayers for family members
 - Asked questions
 - When will Eucharistic Adoration be available
 - When/where will a farewell for Fr. Thomas take place
 - Grateful for Mass streaming
 - Acoustics at 116th make it difficult to understand
 - Appreciative of the call; great thing for the Parish to do

8. New Business

- Grace reported the Deanery meetings has been scheduled for October 28th at St. Augustine's
- > Target dates for Fr. Thomas' farewell August 1st & 2nd, looking into renting a tent
- Eucharistic Adoration
 - When will Eucharistic Adoration be available
 - New Tabernacle will be placed in church during weekdays
 - Juan could open church
 - o Time: 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM Mon-Thu at 106th Street site
 - No books; most do bring their own reading material
 - Usually not more than 4 individuals
 - Participants to use disinfectant wipes at seating area
- Mary Maberry inquired if Council reviewed the Catholic Comeback Matrix provided
- Acknowledgement of Mary Queen of Saints graduates
- Preregistration for 2020-2021 school year to date is 205
- Over 118,000 meals have been provided by Seton Schools to the needy. Our food pantries are going well
- > Tot Lot at 92nd Street to be moved to 116th Street
- ➤ Thank you to Fr. Thomas for his service to our parish and the Pastoral Council for the last 7 years.
