

Celebrating the Sacraments

<u>Baptism</u> is celebrated during or after Mass on the second and fourth Sunday of the month. Other times may be arranged by calling one of the priests. A Baptismal preparation class is required. Classes will be held quarterly in 2019, so it is recommended you schedule a class early, possibly before your child is born. Please call the parish office to register for the class and the Baptism.

Reconciliation (Confession) is celebrated on the First Saturday of the month at 8:30 am at the 92nd Street site and at 3:00 pm on the 116th Street site.

Anointing of the Sick is celebrated communally on the First Saturday of the month after the evening mass at the 116th Street site. Individual anointing may be requested by calling one of the parish priests.

<u>Weddings</u> Please call the Parish office to make arrangements no later than 6 months prior to your anticipated date. A process of preparation including participation in an Archdiocesan Engaged Encounter is required of all couples seeking marriage in the church.

A NEW OFFER ON THE PARISH PROPERTY

Dear Members of MPH,

Last week the Parish received an offer to purchase our 106th street property. The offer was for our full asking price, \$1.75 Million Dollars. As our Finance Council listened to the specific points of the offer, we must remind everyone that it must be processed on several different levels before Finance can make a recommendation to the Transition Team and to the Pastoral Council to accept or reject the offer. Ultimately, if the offer is accepted on our level, it will then go to the Archbishop and the final decision is his.

Next week in our monthly mailing we will go into greater detail explaining both the offer and the process we must follow to move on to the next step. We want all of us to be aware of the offer, and to know that **NO DECISION TO** ACCEPT THE OFFER HAS BEEN MADE AT THIS **TIME**. We hope to have a recommendation to send to the Archbishop before too long and a final decision before the end of Summer. Please carefully read through the next monthly mailing for greater details, and to use the information there to raise any questions you may have.

Thank you and remember to keep all involved in the decision in your prayers in the weeks ahead.


