GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

March 8th, 2020 - 2nd Sunday of Lent

This year our Lenten Outreach Project will be "Congo Helping Hands". A second collection will be taken up this weekend and March 15th.


