### Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes – Monday, March 7, 2022

- Emphasized how qualified our Finance Committee members are
- ➤ MPH is halfway through the fiscal year; we are slightly over budget which is to be expected for the first full year after a Parish transition
- Major repairs upcoming including leaking ceiling windows, boiler, and doors
- School Lease extension to 28 months which includes 2 rent increases
- Budget for 2022-23 Fiscal Year is due June 30 with Budget process commencing March 1
- Parish demographic analysis needs updating
