Mother of Perpetual Help, you have been our refuge from one generation to another.



Help our parish to be an instrument in the hands of God



Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe November 21, 2021

First Reading:

A NOTE FROM FR. MATTHEW

On the last Sunday of each liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King.

Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical Quas primas ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. The Church calls us to acknowledge Christ's kingship with our whole lives: He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things, and cleave to him alone. He must reign in our bodies and in our members, which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls, or to use the words of the Apostle Paul, 'as instruments of justice unto God.'

- Quas primas, 33. This solemnity encourages us to celebrate and live out our faith in public. When we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we declare to the world and remind ourselves that Jesus is the Lord of the Church and of the entire universe.

As we end this liturgical year, we also give thanks for all our blessings with the celebration of Thanksgiving Day. What a beautiful way we conclude this year by reflecting on our blessings and thanking God and each other. It is easy to focus on all the difficulties and challenges we faced, especially as we continue to struggle through the pandemic and forget the wonderful ways God is blessing us. Let us recommit ourselves to living lives of gratitude that foster joy and peace throughout the coming year.

It was so gratifying to see all our liturgical ministers and ministers of care through our outreach ministry gathering this week to re-commit themselves to the various ministries in our parish. It is a beautiful way to give thanks to God for all that we have received from our loving God. Thank you all for your generosity.

I personally thank each one of you for your generosity and kindness with which you have welcomed me into our parish family. I assure you of my special prayers as you gather with family and friends to celebrate this thanksgiving week.




