Intercede for us now with your Son Jesus.



## A NOTE FROM FR. MATTHEW

"My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior.... for the Almighty has done great things for me" (Lk 1:46,47,49)

These words of Mary our Mother, echoed in our hearts as we celebrated our Inaugural Mass of Mother of Perpetual Help Parish last Sunday. It was truly a new beginning, blessed by God and the presence of our wonderful parish community with Bishop Haines. The beautiful liturgy, followed by our great fellowship meal in a festive environment, was very uplifting and renewed our faith and spirit as a community. I thank each one of you who contributed to make this new beginning such a joyful event.

As we step into our new journey of faith Jesus invites us to nurture it with small deeds of faith. In today's Gospel, the disciple John questions Jesus about an unknown exorcist who was driving out demons in Jesus' name. John's question might have been motivated by jealousy. The disciples continue to compare themselves to others who seem to have greater healing powers, and they do not want to share the power of Jesus' name with others.

The disciples observed that the unknown exorcist invoked Jesus' name and was successful in his healing efforts. This unknown healer recognized the power of Jesus' name, yet he was not a follower of Jesus. In his reply to his disciples, Jesus acknowledges that deeds of faith can precede the words of faith.

Later in this Gospel, Jesus teaches us not to create obstacles for those who are just beginning to have faith but to encourage even the smallest signs of faith. The Greek word used here for sin also connotes "stumbling" or "causing scandal." In vivid terms Jesus teaches his disciples the consequences to those who would put obstacles before people who are on the road to faith. Let us be promoters of faith and encourage each other in our journey with the Lord.

We start our Novena to Mother of Perpetual Help Every Friday after Mass
