Eligibility:

- *Must reside in Gibson County Special School District established boundaries;
- *Must have played at least three years of baseball in high school, including senior year;
- *Must plan to attend a two- or four-year college/university, or technical college;
- *Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 calculated after senior mid-term; and/or

Application for the Mike Cooper Memorial Scholarship

1. Have a teacher or other adult (not a relative) who knows you well and will write a positive letter of recommendation. Always allow the recommendation writer as much time as possible. Two weeks is minimally acceptable in order to receive a well-written letter that honors your accomplishments and produces the desired results. **Write a thank-you note to whom wrote you a letter of recommendation!**
2. Read the scholarship description and agreement (see below) so that you are confident you meet the requirements.
3. Write a one page essay to the question below:

“Who is your role model?”

When answering this question, we’re trying to learn more about who you are, **NOT** about your role model. Whether it’s a family member, a teacher, or a sports celebrity, explain how **their actions** have inspired you or what you’ve learned from them and why. Things to think about, but not all inclusive, as you prepare your essay; Justice, Judgment, Dependability, Initiative, Decisiveness, Tact, Integrity, Endurance, Bearing, Unselfishness, Courage, Knowledge, Loyalty, and Enthusiasm.
