A Mission-Driven Model to End the Diseases of Our Generation

Our Mission

The American Center for Cures (ACC) is committed to doing what the traditional research establishment has failed to do: prevent and cure the chronic and deadly diseases that continue to claim millions of American lives.

We operate as a bold, privately-operated, nonpartisan initiative designed to shift the medical research paradigm by treating the quest for cures as a visionary, purpose-driven enterprise rather than a traditional government-regulated project.

The ACC pursues four key strategic objectives:

- **Disease Eradication:** Target the prevention and cure of major illnesses including Alzheimer's, diabetes, Parkinson's, mental illness, heart disease, and various forms of cancer.
- **Strategic Collaboration:** Unite medicine, science, the pharmaceutical industry, and government leadership to tackle long-standing health challenges.
- **Economic Impact:** deploy a \$750 billion bond-funded model structured to generate returns that far-exceed its costs – through pharmaceutical licensing fees and federal savings delivered by each successful cure.
- **Technological Innovation:** Leverage AI, data science, and cross-sector coordination to accelerate clinical trials and breakthroughs.

We are structured around five pillars proven essential to any large-scale scientific breakthrough:

✓ Full, Dedicated Funding	✓ Proven, Dynamic Leadership
✓ A Sound Business Model	✓ Rigorous Accountability
✓ Urgency — because patients cannot wait	

Why this Model Works

The ACC operates in the private sector, free from the bureaucratic friction that has slowed government-run research for decades. Sixteen dedicated units—each focused on a specific disease—will pursue



prevention and cures with the focus, speed, and accountability of a high-performing organization. This is not a grant program. This is a results-driven engine built to serve every American - regardless of income, party affiliation, race, or gender. A cure discovered here belongs to all of us.

The Economic Model

The ACC would be capitalized through the issuance of U.S. Treasury bonds — \$125 billion per year for six years — a total investment of \$750 billion. Interest payments are structured on an incremental annual schedule:

Year 1	Year 2	Year 3+
\$6B interest	\$12B interest	+\$6B per year

Revenue & Return on Investment

The ACC is designed to generate returns that offset—and ultimately far exceed—its costs through two primary streams:

- **Pharmaceutical licensing fees:** ACC-developed compounds that are not preventative or curative will be licensed to pharma partners, generating near-term revenue.
- **Cure-driven federal savings:** Every disease cured translates directly into reduced government healthcare expenditures—permanently.

Consider diabetes alone — widely viewed as the ACC's most achievable near-term target:

Direct federal diabetes expenditures (annual)	\$500B+
Add: cardiovascular disease, amputations, blindness, kidney disease, hypertension	
Total estimated annual economic burden	~\$750B
ACC total investment (6 years)	\$750B
Payback period (diabetes cure alone)	< 1 year

A cure for diabetes alone would recover the ACC's entire six-year investment within a single year — while also saving millions of lives.
