

**The American Center for Cures:

Lou Weisbach is the former founder and CEO of publicly held HA-LO Industries, which he led for 27 years. While leading HA-LO, Mr. Weisbach was a co-owner of Chicago's major league professional soccer team, the Chicago Power. Following his success at HA-LO, Mr. Weisbach became CEO of Stadium Capital, a sports finance company for Morgan Stanley. Mr. Weisbach became very involved in national political campaigns and fundraising, including a stint as Chair of the Jefferson Trust of the Democratic National Committee during the Clinton Administration. Mr. Weisbach also served for two years as a judge in the White House Fellows competition during Donald Trump's administration. Mr. Weisbach succeeded Bob Costas as Chairman of The Giving Back Fund, a national non-profit organization that encourages and facilitates charitable giving by professional athletes, celebrities, high-net-worth individuals, existing non-profit organizations, corporations and others who truly desire to give back. Mr. Weisbach also served as the Director of Prevention & Cures Initiatives for Cancer Treatment Centers of America. Currently Lou is the CEO and Co-founder of In Tickets We Trust LLC and sits on the Board of Justice for Women.

Dr. Richard J. Boxer, MD, FACS, is a Clinical Professor of Urology at the David Geffen School at the University of California, Los Angeles. He is a three-time cancer survivor who has cared for over 7,000 patients with cancer. Dr. Boxer represented the U.S. at the World Health Organization as a private citizen, and he was recently on the Board of Directors of the American Society of Clinical Oncology Conquer Cancer Foundation. In April of 2021, he was awarded the Distinguished Alumni Award by the University of Wisconsin's Medical School, its highest honor. He is on the Board of G4 Alliance, an international organization that promotes excellent care for all surgical patients.

Dr. Boxer has been an attending urologist for our veteran heroes at VA hospitals in Miami and Los Angeles. He has published nearly 100 journal articles and book chapters on medical research. He has also published in the national press on health policy, including in the *New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal*, *Harvard Business Review*, *Real Clear Policy*, *JAMA*, *New England Journal of Medicine*, and *Health Affairs*. Dr. Boxer helped create the clinical protocols for telemedicine beginning 15 years ago, becoming the Chief Medical Officer of numerous telemedicine companies. He has dedicated his professional career to compassionate and uncompromising care for cancer patients and educating the public and the medical community.
