Long Beach has the 2nd busiest container seaport in North ONG BEACH America. \$194 billion worth of trade moves through the

POLB each year. Our Port creates 2.6 million traderelated jobs across the US with 575,000 jobs in Southern California. The POLB serves 140 shipping lines with connections to 217 seaports around the globe.

Under the leadership of the Board of Harbor Commissioners and Executive Director Mario Cordero the POLB is in hot pursuit of being the greenest, most modern, efficient and sustainable seaport in the world.

In addition to moving cargo, the POLB is invested in Long Beach neighborhoods. The POLB's commitment includes community outreach to support family friendly events.
