**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2022-01**

The Town Board of the Town of Lafollette, Burnett County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the town treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appointed position(s) shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per § 60.30(1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officer(s) for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under § 17.001 and required by § 60.30(1e)(f).


This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on November 8, 2022. The referendum question(s) shall be:

"Shall the person holding the office of town treasurer in the Town of Lafollette be appointed by the town board?"

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per § 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by § 60.30(1e)(b).

## NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at an election to be held in the Town of Lafollette on November 8, 2022, the following proposed Ordinance of the Town Board will be submitted to a vote of the people:

Town of Lafollette, Burnet County, Wisconsin  
Ordinance No. 2021-01 - Adopted September 12, 2022

The Town Board of the Town of Lafollette, Burnett County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the town treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

"Shall the person holding the office of town treasurer in the Town of Lafollette be appointed by the town board?"

### EXPLANATION

Voting "Yes" indicates that the voter agrees that the Town Board shall appoint the position of Town Treasurer beginning at the end of the current term (April 2023) and going forward. Voting "No" indicates that the voter wishes that the position of Town Treasurer remains an elected position.
