Meeting called to order at 7:34 pm.

Verification of posting

Meeting minutes were read by Ashley from July 11, 2022. Need to fix that Karen was in attendance and that the motion was made to get bids to gravel Williams Road and Mike made a motion to approve what the fixes are stated, and Scott Seconded it.

Treasurer's report was read by Karen. Scott made a motion to accept, and Mike seconded it.

Tyler Pope for 7500 yards with the royalties is approx. \$35,012.50 without fuel charge. We are responsible for anything over \$5 a gallon plus the screenings.

Opening bids for grinding were open and A1 Excavating out of Bloomer came in at \$5,444.46. Mike made a motion to approve A-1 bid for grinding Williams Road for the Trip S program and Scott seconded it.

Wisconsin Department of Revenue stated that we need different forms filled out which are AT-103, AT-104, and AT-106 for the available of liquor license. The applications need to be turned in by August 23 to give enough time to make things fair. The phone number will be given to Randolph Lucas to contact the Wisconsin Dept of Revenue once it is obtained by Ashley. Scott made the motion that we will accept form AT-106 and a cover letter stating what their business brings to benefit the town and why they would be the best candidate. The cover letter and application must be delivered to Ashley by noon on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 2022. The board will review the applications and set a meeting date for a final decision and Mike seconded it.

Resident issues: ARPA funds can now be used for roads and Scott made a motion to use the funds for road improvements or maintenance and Mike seconded it.

Paid bills and correspondence. The US Bank checks were signed. Mike made a motion to stay with US Bank until the fraud is cleared and Scott seconded it.
