Previous meeting minutes:

May 13, 2024 Call and Close Board of Review minutes were read. Motion to accept by Scott, seconded by Mitch

May 13, 2024 Monthly Board minutes were read. Motion to accept by Scott, seconded by Mitch.

Clerk Report:

- Liquor Licenses verified and approved, posted and completed proper 2024 forms. Collected all fees and entered data for DOR. Distributing framed certificates this week. Done
 - o St. Croix Casino has asked if they can sell intoxicating liquor within convenience store.
 - Verified with State DOR that "Class A" Liquor is not quota based and can be issued based upon Town's regulations and ordinances.
 - Currently we are administrating two separate licenses for Casino, the differences are the premise and Class
 - a) Class B on premise to Casino, Restaurant, Amphitheater
 - b) Class A Beer off premise (retail) to Casino Express Convenience store
 - Town board discussed and unanimously agreed to allow a "Class A" Liquor license to Express Convenience effective July 1, 2024 Jun 30, 2025. Fee of \$300
 - Mitch made motion to allow St Croix Casino to apply for Class A Liquor license, Scott seconded.
- Maintenance of Effort Discussion and education of history and requirement of this new DOR reporting requirement. Even though reporting is required from local Public Safety, (law, fire, ambulance) the town is the one responsible to report and prove an equal or greater level of effort. If we do not file the town can be penalized 15% of Shared revenue received.
 - o We have received the required forms from Siren and Hertel Fire and Ambulance
 - o The Town chose Expenditures and Response time as two categories for maintenance.

<u>Treasurer Report:</u>

- Received all liquor license renewal fees and publication fees.
- Treasurer Report read and moved to accept by Mitch, seconded by Scott.

Monthly Balance Status Report:

- Two areas of overbudget Clerk expenses and Equip maintenance.
- New category added to separate and identify Highway Grant expected through LRIP
- Need to be aware of Highway expenses, spent and expected for the Roads discussion next Monday meeting.

Website:

• Up to date, added pop-up with Fireworks permit information.

White Pine Cemetery

- Opened and closed a site for a private ceremony. No charge
- One plot was marked on plot lines with wooden stakes, now marked with steel stacks need to warn Doug for maintenance.

Road Items:

Twin Lake Road – subdivision requires an end of road cul-de-sac. Coordinating with Ken Erickson on tree removal for area. Town has 66 feet of right-of-way, will need to plan a future project to gravel and put in ditches. 2 of 10 plots sold.

Doug is mowing and on vacation July 3rd – 7th

Ads for bids on 2024 road projects have been posted.

- Williams Road 2 bids
 - o 2.5 inch think qualify for LRIP
 - o .5 inch think to bring total to 3 inches, town will cover
- Warner Lake Road 2 bids
 - Culbertson Rd to Anchor Inn Rd
 - o Anchor Inn Rd to Cranberry Marsh Rd

Estimated costs of projects - decreased by expected LRIP payback and regular road budget expenses = loan amounts to expect.

Electors stated favor of borrowing monies to build roads, all Board in favor of completing full projects in 2024 - but consideration to minimize levy effects should be considered. Do the work, cover the 3 miles with blacktop, but watch the burden. A potential to spread loan over more years, to keep levy amount at same level. Mitch & Darwyn to get loan payment interest quotes based on several options and amounts. Nothing sure until bids are received on June 24th.

3 or 4 years out - Chip Seal new roads, Indian Creek (2028) and Twin Lake Road do after loans paid.

Resident Issues:

• Insurance Claim – no adjuster came when expected to look at roof. Shed is leaking. Unsure about ability to start work, potentially not until fall.

Discussion of basic annual budget allowances, loan options and financial institutions.

It was determined a loan amount of \$260,000 (\$130,000 annually) would keep levy amounts even with prior years.

Scott made a motion to initiate loan process to borrow \$260,000 over 2 years. Mitch seconded. Interest rates and closing costs will determine best institution to use for financing.

Discussion of Additional Expenditures:

Discussion of a potential Grinder and Shredder addition for tractor. Current process of using mower to cut brush, etc. causes repairs, expenses and additional time. It may not cut the large trees, but will eliminate majority of current issues with mower. Town of Jackson has purchased a similar one for about \$29,000. Determined to view Jackson's and have discussion with Diamond Mowers and Baribeau Implements to determine if will function as needed for LaFollette.

Researched to ensure enough gravel was indeed purchased in 2022 to complete the roads projects.
