

## ***White Pine Cemetery Guidelines***

*Guidelines that pertain in plot deed:*

- *Town of LaFollette property owners will be charged \$400 per grave site, non-property owners in the township will pay \$1,000 per site (perpetual care costs included). Charges will be re-evaluated in the future and may increase.*
- *Grave sites are four (4) feet by ten (10) feet in size. All grave sites are contiguous with the adjacent grave sites in the same row.*
- *All monuments require a foundation. Foundation for monuments shall be not less than two feet in width and must be at least two inches larger in dimension, in all directions, than the monument. The monument marker is to be no larger than thirty-eight (38) inches wide and must fit within the foundation dimensions leaving at least two (2) inches within the boarder of the foundation. Foundation must be constructed with a good grade of reinforced concrete and be a minimum of two inches thick. The Town Board representative of the Cemetery Committee will have complete supervision of all memorial erections.*
- *Internment regulations require a minimum one (1) days' notice and cannot take place without a grave site purchase or "cash advance" guarantee from a funeral home. Depth of the grave for traditional burials is to be at least five (5) feet, a vault or grave liner is required. One (1) permanent marker per grave site or cremains is required. The depth for cremains burial is eighteen (18) to twenty-four (24) inches, no vault is required for cremains burials. The opening and closing of the gravesite shall be completed by the funeral home.*
- *A maximum of three cremains may be placed in one grave site or one traditional burial and two cremains. There is a fifty-dollar (\$50.00) fee for each additional cremains burial after the first traditional or cremains burial in a single plot. The cemetery committee secretary must be notified prior to any and all burials in a grave site. A permanent marker is required for each additional burial (cremains or traditional).*
- *White Pine Cemetery Plot Deeds are non-transferrable without written permission from the Cemetery Secretary or Sexton.*
