### Class 1a - 10:00 - Arena 1 - KBIS Club - Senior 60cm

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 60cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Adult, Associate, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies, subject to availability. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

**British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.**

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 60cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Junior, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies, subject to availability. Junior riders should be turning 16 years old or younger in the current year. Riders are eligible to compete on horses from 1st October in the calendar year in which the age of 11 is reached. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Adult, Associate, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies, subject to availability. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Junior, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies, subject to availability. Junior riders should be turning 16 years old or younger in the current year. Riders are eligible to compete on horses from 1st October in the calendar year in which the age of 11 is reached. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump

in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

### **Class 3 - Arena 1 - Equiyd 85cm National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round / 85cm Open**

Rule 318. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2025 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2025 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4\* or 5\* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams). Qualifies for: 85cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Championship Qualifier - Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. 85cm Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Horses may enter 1 section only. This class will be split with 2 sets of prize money awarded. Please clearly state which section is to be entered. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class.

### **Class 4 - Arena 1 - Senior British Novice Championship - First Round/90cm Open**

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- British Novice: Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2021 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior British Novice Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior British Novice Championship - First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Senior British Novice Championship - Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal

Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. • 90cm Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Rule 320. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2025 (assigned for the qualifying Period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2025 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4\* or 5\* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams). Qualifies for: 95cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st September - 31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 95cm National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 95cm National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 95cm Championship Qualifier - Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 95cm National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. 95cm Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Horses may enter 1 section only. This class will be split with 2 sets of prize money awarded. Please clearly state which section is to be entered. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class.

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Discovery: a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2020 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Discovery Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. • 1.00m Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Rule 322. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2025 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4\* or 5\* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams). Qualifies for: 1.05m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.05m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.05m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.05m Championship Qualifier - Second Round competition. The winner of a particular 1.05m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. 1.05m Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Horses may enter 1 section only. This class will be split with 2 sets of prize money awarded. Please clearly state which section is to be entered. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class.

**Class 8 - Arena 1 - Senior Newcomers Championship - First Round/1.10m Open**

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Newcomers:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2019, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Championship - Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to 30th April(subject to revision). If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. • 1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. • All horse/rider combinations eligible for the 1.10m National Amateur First Round will receive dual qualification of double clears, in either section of a Senior Newcomers Championship - First Round/1.10m Open competition. Held at Senior Category 1 shows only.

Rule 294. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who are not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2025. Those riders not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2025 will be eligible to qualify for the National 1.15m Members Cup Final. Qualification criteria apply to both sections. Qualifies for: British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification period: 1st June-31st May. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/rider combination.
