Junior riders should be turning 16 years old or younger in the current year. Riders are eligible to compete on horses from 1st October in the calendar year in which the age of 11 is reached. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st June to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rules 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes, Riders who have ever obtained points on the Gold League are not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final. Pony/Rider combinations who have ever obtained points on the Silver League are also not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final. Qualifies for: Four double clear rounds to qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships. Two double clear rounds will also qualify for Cats & Pipes at The Scope Festival. Qualifying Period: 1st July - 30th June for Stepping Stones. 1st January-31st July for Cats & Pipes. Numbers to qualify: Those pony/rider combinations who achieve four double clears (subject to revision) will qualify for the Final. Those ponies who achieve two double clears will also qualify for the Cats & Pipes Championship at The Scope Festival. If run as a Handicap, pony riders will be given dispensation to ride up to three ponies in each height section. No rider may compete more than three ponies in the same section.

Kindly sponsored by STX-UK Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- British Novice: For registered ponies in Grade JD, that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13. Qualifies for: STX-UK Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.
- 80cm Open: For registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. If combined with an open: In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

### **Class 9 - Arena 1 - Springboard 128/138cm Handicap**

Rule 415. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 90cm / 1.00m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rule 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes: • In the 128cms section, Junior riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 10 years is reached. Riders who reach the age of 10 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 500 points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination). • In the 138cms section, Junior riders are eligible to enter, irrespective of points achieved, before the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached. Riders who reach the age 12 years and over in the current calendar year must not have won a total of 850 points. (as of 01.08.2017 pony/rider combination). Junior Riders are not eligible to enter the 138cms section until the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. Ponies 128cm & under are not permitted to enter the 138cm section. Once riders have competed at, or have 'ever' qualified for RIHS or HOYS on any height pony they are no longer eligible to compete in the Final. Pony/rider combinations who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the final of this competition. Qualifies for: Springboard Final. Qualifying Period: 1st February -31st January. Numbers to Qualify: Four double clears to qualify for the Final. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. In order to compete in the Final, all qualified competitors ages must be in accordance with the Rule 77.12 & 77.13 in the year of the Final. If run as a Handicap, pony riders will be given dispensation to ride up to three ponies in each height section. No rider may compete more than three ponies in the same section.

Qualifies for: Pony Discovery Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify for: Those ponies which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Discovery First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Pony Discovery Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony Discovery First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. • 90cm Open: For registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

- 138cm Section: For registered ponies exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms to be ridden by Junior Members (ages in accordance with Rule 77.12). Pony riders are not eligible to compete before the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. Qualifies for: Winter 138cms Second Round Competition & Horse Of The Year Show 138cm Second Round. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision).
- 128cm Section: For registered ponies not exceeding 128cms to be ridden by Junior Members (ages in accordance with Rule 77.13). Junior riders are not eligible to compete before the calendar year in which their 8th birthday is reached. Qualifies for: Winter 128cms Second Round Competition & Horse Of The Year Show 128cm Second Round. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify (subject to revision). Dispensation will be given to run the Winter 128cms and Winter 138cms First Rounds as a handicap competition. If run as a Handicap, pony riders will be given dispensation to ride up to three ponies in each height section. This class will split in the event of 20 starters or more and two sets of prize money awarded. No rider may ride more than three ponies in the same competition, in accordance with rule 77.6.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Pony Newcomers Second Rounds.
- The Open Section is for registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Junior Members, in either the Open or the Newcomers Section who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final. Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination. Ponies may compete in one section only.
