Class 1 - Arena 1 - KBIS Club - Senior 60cm

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 60cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Adult, Associate, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies, subject to availability. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st July to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 2 - Arena 1 - KBIS Club - Senior 70cm

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 70cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Adult, Associate, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies, subject to availability. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st July to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 3 - Arena 1 - KBIS Club - Senior 80cm

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 80cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to competitors that are not registered with British Showjumping, as well as Adult, Associate, Club or Just For Schools Members. Competitors may compete on horses or ponies, subject to availability. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. There is no age restriction on riding a pony. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes. Qualifying period: 1st July to 31st May. Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the five height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping Academy Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations only are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category. Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3. Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters are eligible for placing points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Class 4 - Arena 1 - Equissage Pulse Senior British Novice First Round/90cm Open

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- British Novice: Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2021 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior British Novice Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior British Novice Championship - First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Senior British Novice Championship - Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be

split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. • 90cm Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Class 5 - Arena 1 - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Discovery: a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6. b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2020 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Discovery Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6. Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. If combined with an open: In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded. In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters. • 1.00m Open: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Class 6 - Arena 1 - Senior 1.05m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Club Members are NOT eligible.

Prizes: 1st: £35.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £18.00, 5th: £18.00, 6th: £18.00, Total: £144.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Class 7 - Arena 1 - Senior Newcomers Championship – First Round /1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Newcomers: a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2019, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Championship Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Championship - Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to 30th April (subject to revision). If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. • 1.10m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Class 8 - Arena 1 - National 1.15m Members Cup Qualifier/Senior 1.15m Open

Rule 294. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who are not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2024. Those riders not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2024 will be eligible to qualify for the National 1.15m Members Cup Final. Qualification criteria apply to both sections. Qualifies for: British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification period: 1st June-31st May. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/rider combination.

Class 9 - Arena 1 - Redpost Equestrian Senior Foxhunter - First Round /1.20M Open

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

Kindly sponsored by Redpost Equestrian Ltd In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Foxhunter:(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2018, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify. Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st May to 30th April (subject to revision). Rule 102.16 British Showjumping hind boot rule for boots/leg protection applies in this class. Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2024 are not eligible for qualification to the 2025 Championship. If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.
- 1.20m Open: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £45.00, 3rd: £40.00, 4th: £30.00, 5th: £20.00, 6th: £20.00, Total: £205.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 10 - Arena 1 - National 1.30m Open

Rule 306. Single Phase. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members. Club Members are NOT eligible. Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June. Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))
