A1ST - Ability1st

Description: Ability1st's goal is to empower persons with disabilities and help enable them to live independently with a high quality of life. They provide stable housing, support and advocacy for victims of crime, home modifications to persons with disabilities who want to stay in their homes.

ACES - Advancing Past the ACEs

Description: Advancing Past the ACEs is dedicated to building a future where every child and family has the support, care, and resources to thrive beyond the challenges of adverse childhood experiences. They provide support through a network of resources to help individuals overcome trauma and build brighter futures.

BBC - Big Bend Cares

Description: Big Bend Cares promotes community wellness by providing comprehensive HIV/AIDS care, including testing, education, medical services, and housing. Their mission is to improve health and support those affected by HIV/AIDS.

CACAA - Capital Area Community Action Agency

Description: The Capital Area Community Action Agency provides a comprehensive, seamless system of services and resources to reduce the detrimental effects of poverty, empower low-income citizens with skills and motivation to become self-sufficient, and improve the overall quality of their lives, and our community.

CAHSC - Capital Area Healthy Start Coalition, Inc.

Description: Capital Area Healthy Start is dedicated to connecting new or expecting moms, fathers, and families with young children to community resources that help with pregnancy and parenting. Description: Capital Medical Society Foundation's mission is to support the charitable efforts of physicians and others, increase access to healthcare, promote education and serve the community's health needs through innovative projects that are exemplary, affordable and dignified. Capital Medical Foundation's We Care Network program was created by Capital Medical Society physicians to create an organized, coordinated approach to provide charity care to low-income uninsured adults in the community.

CARTER - Carters Carter Communty Services

Description: Carter's Corner provides professional community and athletic consulting to local agencies, sports program and families. Their services include fundraising, community events, athletic consultation, career planning, vending and more. They provide quality-coaching tips to each athlete and feature stories highlighting many of their athlete's accomplishments.

CONNECT - Connection First, Inc.

Description: Connection First, Inc. cultivates peace and healing through restorative practices and nonviolent communication, aiming to foster meaningful human connections and resolve conflicts.

DASH - DASH Foundation

Description: The DASH Foundation supports young adults aging out of foster care by providing coaching, housing, and mental health services. Their goal is to empower these individuals to succeed by developing personal and professional skills.

ELDER - Elder Care Services, Inc.

Description: Elder Care Services provides community based, compassionate care for a broad spectrum of seniors. For active seniors, they provide an avenue to stay engaged in the community through volunteering placement. For families beginning the aging process, they are an advocate and trusted resource. For frail and homebound seniors, they continue to provide a variety of services that promote independence and safety while individuals age in place.

GOTRP - Girls on the Run Panhandle

Description: Girls on the Run has fun, evidence-based programs that inspire participants to recognize their inner strength, increase their level of physical activity, imagine their possibilities, and confidently stand up for themselves and others.

INCL - Inclusion Cafe

Description: Inclusion Cafe's goal is to employ up to 30 individuals with intellectual disabilities learning multiple positions in a fully functional restaurant open during lunch hours, here in Tallahassee, FL. In addition, they will offer an specialized training academy called Inclusion Cafe Academy. They'e asking local Chefs and restauranteurs to volunteer their time teaching those who do not work at the cafe, restaurant skills to prepare them for employment throughout our community.

INDLAN - Independence Landing

Description: Independence Landing is a safe, affordable residential community with a range of amenities for adults with intellectual and/or cognitive disabilities.

JLT - Junior League of Tallahassee

Description: The Junior League of Tallahassee is creating real change in the Big Bend by advancing social activism-focused projects that directly benefit our local community! We make a positive impact through effective action and leadership. Their mission is to advance women's leadership for meaningful community impact through volunteer action, collaboration, and training.

KIDS - Kids Incorporated of the Big Bend

Description: Kids Incorporated of the Big Bend is a community-based organization providing reliable and affordable childcare for at-risk families with children ages 0-3. Through extremely low teacher to child ratios (1:4) and small class sizes, Kids Incorporated's Early Head Start Program individualizes the curriculum to ensure each child's learning plan is based on their developmental level.

LAFT - Legal Aid Foundation of Tallahassee

Description: Their mission is to mobilize and educate volunteer attorneys and provide direct legal services to those in need. Their vision is for the Leon County Community to be working together to ensure all people are aware of and able to access their civil legal rights. They help provide those who qualify with pro bono legal representation.

LSNF - Legal Services of North Florida

Description: LSNF provides representation to low-income and vulnerable individuals in civil matters only. Eligibility for assistance may be based on income and assets of all members of the household and the legal problem. LSNF serves the legal needs of children, elderly, victims of abuse, veterans, and people with disabilities. LSNF's priority areas include supporting families; preserving the home; maintaining economic stability; safety, stability and health.

LIFE - Life Worth Leading

Description: Life Worth Leading improves lives through advocacy, exercise, and leadership development activities. They provide opportunities for veterans, people with disabilities, and underserved populations through training, career coaching, employability skills, recreation including SCUBA diving and cycling, and work with rescued animals.

MADD - MADD Northwest Florida

Description: MADD Northwest Florida's goal is to create a future of no more victims. MADD provides as many services as possible to victims of drugged and drunk driving crashes all at no charge. They provide emotional support, resources, education, crime victims compensation, support with preparing systems, referrals, information & assistance.

META - MetaVisions

Description: MetaVisions supports children of all abilities. They have supported various efforts in order to fill gaps or barriers in existing pediatric systems of care including, but not limited to: maternal child health, child development, father and son attachment, families experiencing incarceration, behavioral health, autism supports and more.

NMC - Neighborhood Medical Center, Inc.

Description: Neighborhood Medical Center is your home for healthcare, providing Primary Care, Mental Health, and Dental services to all of our patients, regardless of their ability to pay. Their mission is to provide high quality, comprehensive and compassionate healthcare.

NFLOPG - North FL Office of Public Guardian

Description: NFOPG serves adults with mental and/or physical disabilities as their court-appointed legal guardian. The Mission and Purpose of NFOPG is to: Provide quality guardianship services to vulnerable adults who have no resources to obtain a guardian otherwise; Through guardianship services, enhance quality of life and protect against abuse, neglect and exploitation; To ensure every person's voice is heard and each life is maximized to the fullest.

OMEGA - Omega Lamplighters, Inc.

Description: Omega Lamplighters, Incorporated is a youth leadership organization for young men in grades Fourth through Twelfth founded in 2008 by Royle King II. Their mission is to prepare young men to be responsible citizens through a village of community mentors teaching perseverance, self-awareness, and confidence.

SAFE - Safe Families for Florida

Description: Safe Families for Florida's goal is to engage families via faith communities to open their homes to care for vulnerable children. The North Florida chapter has had nearly 7,000 children placed into 1,400 Host Family homes. Seventy-five percent of children placed are under the age of 6 years old. Over 90% of the kids return to their parents or a relative that is identified to take over.

SHBB - Second Harvest of the Big Bend

Description: Second Harvest BB is dedicated to feeding the hungry and food-insecure. Their programs are: senior nutrition, child nutrition, disaster relief, mobile pantries, nutrition education, SNAP assistance, and food recovery.

OASIS - The Oasis Center for Women and Girls

Description: The Oasis Center was created to be a community resource center for women and girls to come together, dream, achieve, and thrive. Their mission is to improve the lives of women and girls through celebration and support. They provide support services for women and girls including free/low-cost individual counseling, support groups, girls circles, summer camp, and more.

WHOLE - Whole Child Leon

Description: Whole Child Leon seeks to engage the entire community in a commitment to our youngest residents because their future – and ours – hinges on ensuring the best start for every child. Their goals are: Creating Community Ownership and Participation in Early Childhood Success, Ensure all Children are Healthy at Age 1, Ensure Children are Making Appropriate Progress, Ensure Children Enter Kindergarten Ready to Succeed.
