The following individual is requesting treatment with Observed & Experiential Integration (OEI), a new eye-related treatment for psychological trauma & dissociation. OEI treatment involves the following eye-related activities:

- Tracking a visual stimulus in various directions (vertically, horizontally, in circular patterns, etc.);

- Alternately covering the L and R eyes and having clients track into the extreme lateral visual fields;
- Having clients track a moving object (usually therapists fingers) above the head & below the chin;
