The Labor and Industry Committee and the Criminal Justice Committee worked together to investigate 56 complaints of discrimination in the third quarter, up 14.29% vs previous year.

The top 5 types of complaints were as follows:

- Employment - 33.93%
- Housing - 17.86%
- Public Business - 7.14%
- Police Misconduct - 5.36%
- Education - 5.36%

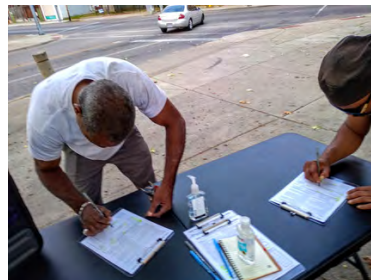
