## Exhibitor Responsibility Reminder

While the livestock shows and auctions may be over, the fair remains open through Sunday, and your animals are still on exhibit. As an exhibitor, you are responsible for continuing to care for your animals, including providing water and feed on Saturday night and Sunday.

Your animal remains part of a public educational display, and you play a vital role in demonstrating responsible animal care to fair visitors and youth. Neglecting your animal after the sale sends the wrong message about our program and the values we uphold in raising livestock for harvest.

If you are found in violation of this responsibility, your Junior Livestock Auction (JLA) check will not be issued. Instead, the funds will be returned to your buyer with an explanation of the neglect, and you and possibly your club/chapter will be ineligible for participation in the 2027 Kings Fair.
