Online Entry Registration Deadline: Due on or by **Sunday, May 19, 2024**, midnight. FREE Online Entry Only (if you need help stop by the fair office or call, we will help or enter your items for you).

ARTWORK RECEIVED: Wednesday, June 5, 2024 & Thursday, June 6, 2024 - 10:00am - 6:00pm. The ARTWORK DROP OFF is Wednesday & Thursday ONLY (Take exhibits to the ROSE Building).

ARTWORK RELEASED: Monday, June 17, 2024 - 10am- 6:00pm (All exhibits must be picked up on Monday in the Fine Arts Building). Items not picked up will be properly disposed of or donated.



DEPARTMENT RULES FOR ADULTS, SENIORS, & OPEN JUNIORS:

1. All entries must have been completed within the last two years and NOT previously exhibited at The Kings Fair. Entries are limited to residents of Fresno, Kings, and Tulare Counties unless otherwise specified.
2. **Online Entry Registration Deadline:** On or before Sunday, May 19, 2024, midnight, online only **FREE** to Enter. Exhibitor is limited to two entries per class unless otherwise specified.
3. List only Fine Art and Photography entries on the Department Online Registration System. Fine Art and Photography are listed as one department. For example, you can enter a painting, photograph, and sculpture from the list online.
4. Entries are at the exhibitor's own risk. The utmost care will be given to all entries; however, The Kings Fair accepts no responsibility for loss, stolen or damage of any kind to any entry. Your completed online entry is the acceptance of this rule. There is a police presence on the grounds during the Kings Fair.
5. All works (fine art and photography) must be titled for identification purposes. Please have your name and the title on the back of your entry in case a tag falls off exhibit item.
6. Each artist may set a price for each entry if wishing to sell. All inquiries regarding the sale of entries will be referred directly to the exhibitor to complete the sale. Simply print the selling price and phone number on a separate tag.
7. The Kings Fair reserves the right to exclude entry, which is not in the best interest of the fair and reserves the right to disqualify any exhibitor(s) who conducts themselves in an inappropriate manner, without discussion or justification. No payment of any awards will be made to individuals who have been disqualified.
8. Ribbons will be awarded as the Judge deems worthy. There can only be one placement level ribbon per class. Only one first place winner from each class can compete for the next level, **Best of Division**. Only "**Best of Division**" winners can compete for "**Best of Show**." Adults will be judged using the **American system** of judging -1st - 5th place and youth the **Danish systems** of judging 1st - 5th place.
9. **SENIOR:** Open to any adult that is **65** years old or older
10. **JUNIOR:** All junior exhibitor age is determined by the year entry has been completed. (i.e., if exhibitor turns 18 years old before Kings Fair, they are still eligible for the junior division.) Each entry in these junior classes shall have been made or produced by the exhibitor. This division is open to those juniors who are not entered in 4-H classes of the same category. Entries shall be submitted from online divisions and classes provided by the Kings Fair online system. The signature of parent or guardian is required in the Parent Field. **State and local rules apply to all entries.** Adults are judged **American style** and Youth are **judged Danish style**.

11. All entries must be picked up on **Monday June 17, 2024**, between 10:00am to 7:00pm. Any artwork left after this time will be disposed of properly, donated or recycled.

FINE ART RULES:

1. All entries must be framed or matted; exceptions are made for canvas and sculpture works of art. For youth artwork they may simply be matted on construction paper to prevent stapling artwork.

2. **Adults:** Framed with wires and hooks. Exhibits must have proper hardware for hanging or exhibits cannot be judged. **No Sawtooth allowed for hanging.**

3. **Seniors:** Framed with wires and hooks.

4. **Juniors:** Minimum size of 8"x10" or larger. Mounted on matte board or construction paper. Only high school students are allowed the option of having their artwork framed. Canvas works of art for all ages are welcomed.

5. **Sculpture:** Large and delicate exhibit items may be handled and installed by the exhibitor during check-in on the floor area with the supervision of the Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent during receiving days.

ADULT/JUNIOR & 4-H PHOTOGRAPHY RULES:

1. Pictures must have been taken within one year of the opening date of The Kings Fair.
2. **MATTED:** All entries must be no smaller than 5" x 7" and no larger than 14" x 18" photograph with a mat that goes at least 2" around the picture. No frames, hooks, wires, string, or tape. REQUIRED: Attach a 7/8" or larger sticky Velcro tape to the back of each corner of your mat. Use the prickly side of the Velcro and not the fuzzy side.
3. **FRAMED/CANVAS:** Entries can be of any size or length, including vertical or horizontal panoramic images. Please keep in mind that space is limited (nothing too large). Must have proper hardware for hanging (wires and hooks) or exhibit cannot be judged. All photographs must be framed unless your work is on a box frame that does not require a frame. This applies to adults and juniors.

2. All pictures **MUST BE PROPERLY MOUNTED** with scrapbook tape or dry mount tissue on mat board ready for hanging.
3. Mount your entry on mat board no smaller than 8" X 10" and no larger than 16" x 20". It should have at least 2" borders.
4. Size Limitations: Photographic prints must be no smaller than 5: x 7" and no larger than 8" x 10".
5. All sequence pictures are to be mounted on a 16"x20" board.
6. Computer altered photograph. Exhibitors must do photograph and computer alterations or enhancements.
7. Exhibits will be accepted and judged by the **Danish System**.
