This is a web-based program that each exhibitor can complete at home. Visit <u>kingsfair.com</u> to register and complete certification. **Proof of completion will be required with entry submission.**

NO POULTRY ON-SITE FOR THE 2025 KINGS FAIR

Limited to one MEAT PEN entry – Poultry must be raised and kept at home. Poultry will be sold in an ONLINE VIDEO SALE. Participation in all Poultry Competition Guidelines is MANDATORY for Sale Eligibility.

WEIGH YOUR MEAT BIRDS AT HOME – Submit each bird's weight and leg band ID to the Livestock Office at 9:00 AM, Wednesday, June 18, 2025.

RULES

- **Mandatory!** All livestock exhibitors must complete the Youth Quality Assurance Certification Program. Proof of completion must accompany entry submissions.
- ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY!
- To enter a poultry meat pen eligible for the 2025 Kings Fair Video Sale, exhibitors must also enter and complete the Kings Fair Poultry Knowledge Competition and create an Educational Board.
- Participants must be at least 7 years old to enter animal divisions.

RULES

- Each participant must be a member of a Kings County 4-H Club, California Grange, or FFA Poultry Project.
- Chickens must weigh between 4 to 7 lbs. each to qualify for sale.
- Turn in bird weights and leg band numbers to the Livestock Office by **9:00 AM**, Wednesday, June 18, 2025.
- Meat pens will **not be judged**; weight and completion of Knowledge Competition and Educational Board are required for JLA sale eligibility.
- Exhibitors are responsible for harvesting and delivering chickens to buyers. A signed slip and Thank You note must be submitted to receive a JLA check unless the buyer donates the chickens back to the exhibitor.
- By June 3rd, exhibitors will receive an email with instructions for uploading photos for the video sale. Photos must be uploaded by June 16, 2025. Birds must be clean, and exhibitors must be in uniform in the photo.
- Exhibitors may only sell **one animal** at the Junior Livestock Auction.
- Exhibitors with multiple animals must notify the Poultry Superintendent and Livestock Office which animal they are selling within **30 minutes after Market Animal Judging**.
- Blue Ribbon winners may sell at the Junior Livestock Auction if it is the only animal being sold.
- Sold meat pens may be donated back to the exhibitor but may **not** be resold at the auction.
- Both birds in the meat pen must have the **same number** on both leg bands.

KINGS FAIR POULTRY KNOWLEDGE COMPETITION

Exhibitors must wear the official uniform of the organization they represent.

RULES

- This is a hands-on knowledge competition using 3D models.
- A poultry judge will interact with exhibitors and ask age-appropriate questions.
- Exhibitors will work through three (3) stations. Study guides and materials have been provided to all leaders and advisors by the Fair (purchased from Realityworks).

Competition Stations:

- Poultry Breeds
- Poultry Anatomy
- Poultry Harvest
- Advanced FFA, Senior 4-H, and Intermediate 4-H competitors will complete a 30–50 question quiz after the stations.
- Educational Boards will be judged by age division as part of the Knowledge Competition. (No separate poster entry required.)
- Competition will be held in the Beef Ring, behind the Poultry Barn.



- Raising a meat pen is optional; exhibitors may enter the competition without raising poultry for the 2025 JLA.
- **FFA Novice Competition Champion** is eligible for Small Animal Round Robin Showmanship.
- Judge's decisions are FINAL. Any adult interference may result in exhibitor disqualification.
