RULES:

- 1. The Kings Fair has established new rules for show attire for all livestock exhibitors. Refer to individual exhibitor section for new attire. No exhibitor will be allowed to show or exhibit wearing blue jeans, open toe shoes or tee shirts. All shirts/blouses must have a collar and have long sleeves. Tank tops or sleeveless shirts are not allowed. Please look in the Livestock Department for 4-H & FFA dress attire.
- 2. RABBIT ENTRY FORM is on the www.kingsfair.com website.
- 3. I.D. Numbers MUST BE LISTED.
- 4. Official A.R.B.A. Sanctioned Show, Eric Stewart, Executive Director, P.O. Box 400, Knox, PA 16232. Membership Dues: Adult \$20.00 or \$50.00 for 3 yrs. Combination Husband/Wife \$30.00 or \$75.00 for 3 yrs. Youth \$12.00 or \$30.00 for 3 yrs.
- 5. Rules, definitions and judging procedures as described in the latest edition of the Guide Book and The Standard of Perfection, of the American Rabbit Breeder's Association, Inc. shall apply to all district and county fair rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
- 6. All animals must be identified by permanent ear tattoo (in left ear) conforming to the Entry Form upon arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same division must be eliminated.
- 7. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper division and class for breed, variety, age and sex only.
- 8. All animals are entered at owner's risk. Judges and fair management are not responsible for the injury to or the death of any animal.
- 9. Exhibitors are to be responsible for their animals to and from the judging table. If the exhibitor cannot be there to carry their animals, it is their responsibility to find someone who can. No classes will be re-judged because of missing animals or exhibitors.
 - Substitutions will be allowed only in the same breed, sex, class and variety as the original entry. Substitutions may be made by
 calling the show Superintendent, Kathy Lugo (559) 582-4760 no later than Sunday, June 8, 2025. NO CHANGES WILL BE
 MADE ON SHOW DAY.

- 11. If the breed has more than one variety of color, indicate variety or color on your Entry Form.
- 12. It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to feed and water their own rabbits. Please bring your own food dish and water bottle. Tuna cans may be wired to cages, if desired.
- 13. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN UP (DURING CHECK IN) FOR 1, TWO (2) HOUR BARN DUTY SHIFT. A \$50.00 fine will be imposed on those that do not signup or do not show up for barn duty.
- 14. Independent exhibitors must be at least 9 years old by December 31, 2024. Youth under 9 years of age must exhibit in special small animal and non-livestock divisions designated by the local fair.

RABBIT MEAT PENS

LIMITED TO KINGS COUNTY 4-H, FFA & CALIF. GRANGE ONLY. Entry Form **ONLINE**.

Limit: 2 meat pens per exhibitor

DANISH SYSTEM OF JUDGING ENTRY FEE: \$15 PER PEN/PER CLASS LIMIT: One Entry Per Grand Champion

RULES:

- 1. Meat pens consist of 3 rabbits, all the same breed and variety, not over 70 days old, and weighing between 3 ½ and 5 ½ lbs. each. List all 3 ear markings on the Entry Form and send only one entry fee per pen.
- 2. A Bill of Sale or statement certifying that rabbits were bred by exhibitor showing a minimum of 30 days ownership required at weighin
- 3. Exhibitor can only sell ONE SPECIE ANIMAL at the Junior Livestock Auction. If the exhibitor has a Market Animal the exhibitor is to choose which animal to sell and notify the Rabbit Superintendent and Livestock Office within half hour after the Market Animal has been judged.
- Champion and Reserve Champion meat pens can sell at Junior Livestock Auction unless the exhibitor prefers to sell their Large Market Animal.
- 5. Blue ribbon winners may sell at the Junior Livestock Auction if that is the only animal being sold at Saturday's Auction.
- 6. Sold meat pens may be donated back to exhibitor, but not resold in auction.

There will be no premiums paid on meat pens.
