**EVACUATION PREPAREDNESS  
RABBITS**

**FOOD**

- Two week supply of pet's normal food
- Airtight, waterproof container for dry food
- Extra food bowl
- Two week supply of hay
- Airtight, waterproof container for hay — seal shut only during transportation

**WATER**

- Two week supply of bottled water (including enough to clean bowls) — store in cool, dark place
- Extra water bowl or water bottle

**SANITATION AND CLEANING SUPPLIES**

- Dish soap for cleaning food and water bowls
- Paper towels
- Litterbox (appropriate size for cage)
- Two week supply of carefresh litter
- Scoop for litter
- Plastic bags for disposing of waste
- Disinfecting cleaner for cleaning cage and litterbox

**EVACUATION AND HOUSING**

- Evacuation
- Carrier for each rabbit or pair of rabbits
- EvacSak for each rabbit or pair of rabbits
- Housing**
- Collapsible wire crate (w/room for small litterbox)
- Large plastic airline crate (w/room for small litterbox)
- Exercise pen
- Towel to cover enclosure or cage
- Frozen liter or two liter bottles of water during hot weather to help prevent heat stroke

- Red Cross recommended pet first aid kit
- First aid book for rabbits
- Two week supply of any long term medications
- Simethicone
- Powdered Pedialyte
- Critical Care or vegetable baby food
- Oral syringes

### HORSES

#### SUPPLIES ( per horse)

##### HAY

- \_ One week supply of hay
- \_ Airtight, waterproof container for hay — seal shut only during transportation

##### SPECIALTY FEED

- \_ One week supply of horse's normal food
- \_ Airtight, waterproof container for specialty food
- \_ Extra food bucket

##### WATER

- \_ One week supply of water — 50 gallon barrels can be used
- \_ Extra water bucket

##### SANITATION AND CLEANING SUPPLIES

- \_ One week supply of shavings to spread in stall
- \_ Extra pitch fork & manure rake
- \_ Extra wheelbarrow or muck buckets
- \_ PDZ or lime (neutralizer for urine amonia)

##### GROOMING / MAINTAINANCE

- \_ 2 Hoof Picks
- \_ Stiff Brush
- \_ Curry comb
- \_ towel /wash cloth
- \_ hoof rasp/ file
- \_ hoof knife
- \_ hoof nippers
- \_ scissors

## HORSE EVACUATION:

### TRAILER:

- \_ **Horse trailers** (maintain with periodic safety checks) (availability for number of horses needed)
- \_ Trucks that can safely pull trailers
- \_ Shipping boots or wraps (if necessary)
- \_ Rope to tie out horse (must be trained to tether)
- \_ Leather Halter (emergency for haltering day before )
- \_ Rope halter
- \_ Lead rope 10' (cotton)
- \_ Feed bucket with tie down (trailer stall)
- \_ 2 - 5gal water jugs (filled. Replace water every two weeks)

### HOUSING:

- \_ Portable Corral /Round Ring
- \_ Fairgrounds stables
- \_ Local residents
- \_ Animal Shelter(s)
- \_ Beach (parking lot or sand)
- \_ Shopping Center parking lot

- \_ Bandage/regular scissors Bandaging tape

- \_ Latex or rubber gloves

- \_Stopwatch
- \_1 to 2-foot section of pipe (PVC or steel), to make a temporary splint until the vet arrives

**MEDICATIONS:** (talk with vet first before administering)  
( Two week supply of any long term medication )

- \_Phenylbutazone (bute)
- \_Acepromazine (Ace)
- \_Banamine
- \_Syringe and needles

**HOOF CARE:**

- \_Epsom salts
- \_Hoof pick
- \_Hoof knife
- \_Hoof rasp/file
- \_Hoof boots/ Sport Boots /wraps

**WOUND CARE:**

- \_Antiseptic wound wash
- \_Antiseptic cream/ointment
- \_Antiseptic spray

## DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

### CHICKENS & DUCKS

#### FOOD

- \_ Two week supply of pet's normal food
- \_ Airtight, waterproof container for dry food
- \_ Gravel (only if necessary for your bird)
- \_ Extra bowl

#### WATER

- \_ Two week supply of bottled water (include enough to clean water containers) - store in cool, dark place
- \_ Extra water container

#### SANITATION AND CLEANING SUPPLIES

- \_ Dish soap for cleaning food bowls and water containers
- \_ Paper towels
- \_ Two week supply of cage liner (newspaper, etc.)
- \_ Plastic bags for disposing of waste
- \_ Disinfecting cleaner for cleaning cage

#### EVACUATION AND HOUSING

- \_ Small evacuation cages that bird cannot chew out of
- \_ Net
- \_ Towel
- \_ Flash light for regulating light hours
- \_ Pliers for any cage repairs
- \_ Extra batteries

#### FIRST AID KIT AND FIRST AID BOOK

- \_ Red Cross recommended pet first aid kit
- \_ First aid book for birds
- \_ Two week supply of any long term medications
- \_ Flour or cornstarch (not hemostatic powder)
- \_ Vetwrap (not gauze or adhesive tape)
